ORDER:

The Government accordingly do and hereby direct that the adhoc rules be framed for the posts of Research Assistant and Microbiologist, Institute of Microbiology, Madras Medical College, Chennai.

APPENDIX.**NOTIFICATION-I.**

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following Rules :-

2. The Rules hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on and from the 16th December 2014.

RULES.

The General Rules for the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Service and the Special Rules applicable to the holders of the permanent post in Branch-I Medical of the Tamil Nadu Medical Service shall apply to the holder of the temporary post of Research Assistant at the Institute of Microbiology, Madras Medical College, Chennai, subject to the modifications specified in the following Rules:

Provided that with effect on and from the 15th September 2016, the provisions contained in the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016 (Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 2016) and the Special Rules applicable to the holders of the permanent posts in Branch-I Medical of the Tamil Nadu Medical Service shall apply to the holder of the post.

2. Constitution.— The post shall constitute a distinct class in the said service.

3. Appointment.— Appointment to the post shall be made as follows:-

- (i) by recruitment by transfer from the Tamil Nadu Medical Subordinate Service;
- (ii) by direct recruitment, if no qualified and suitable candidate is available for appointment to the post by the above method.

4. Qualifications.— (a) Age.— No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by direct recruitment, if he has completed or will complete thirty two years of age on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made;

(b) Other Qualification.— No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post, unless he possesses the following qualifications namely:-

- (i) a Post Graduate degree in Microbiology of any university recognized by the University Grants Commission; and
- (ii) must have served in Leptospirosis Laboratory for a period of not less than five years.

5. Probation.— (a) Every person appointed to the post by direct recruitment shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years;

(b) Every person appointed to the post by recruitment by transfer shall from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years.

6. Tests.— (a) Every person appointed to the post shall pass the Account Test for Executive Officers within the period of his probation;

(b) Every person appointed to the post shall also pass the Departmental Test in the Tamil Nadu Medical Code within a period of four years from the date of appointment, failing which future increments in the time scale pay shall be postponed without cumulative effect till he pass the said test.

7. Pay.– There shall be paid to the holder of the post, a monthly pay calculated in the Pay Band of PB3 of Rs.15600 – 39000 with Grade pay of Rs.5400:

Provided that with effect on and from the 1st January 2016, a monthly pay shall be calculated in Level 22 – Rs.56100 – 177500 under the Tamil Nadu Revised Pay Rules, 2017.

8. Saving.– Nothing contained in these rules shall adversely affect any person holding the post as on the date of publication of these Rules in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.
