## **ORDER:**

The Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy has sent a proposal for starting three years Post Graduate Degree Course at Government Yoga and Naturopathy Medical College, Chennai duly stating that in Tamil Nadu, there are no Post Graduate Degree Courses available in the field of Yoga and Naturopathy System of Medicine and that the Students are going to other States to study the M.D Degree Courses in Yoga and Naturopathy System of Medicine.

- 2. The Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy has requested orders of the Government to start three years Post Graduate Degree Course at Government Yoga and Naturopathy Medical College, Chennai and to sanction posts, buildings, furnitures, etc., at a total cost of Rs.12.40 Crore.
- 3. During the Budget session 2014-2015 on the floor of the Assembly, the Hon'ble Minister (Health) announced that three years Post Graduate Degree Courses in three Specialties viz., M.D (Naturopathy), M.D (Yoga) and M.D (Acupuncture) with an intake of 5 (five) students in each speciality, will be started.
- 4. Accordingly, the Government hereby order to start three years Post Graduate Degree Course in three specialities viz., MD(Naturopathy), MD (Yoga) and MD (Acupuncture), with an intake of 5 (five) students in each speciality, in the Government Yoga and Naturopathy Medical College, Chennai from the academic year 2014-2015 and accord sanction of the posts, buildings, furnitures etc., for a total sum of Rs.9.67 crore (Rupees Nine Crore and Sixty seven lakhs only) as detailed in the annexure to this order.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:
