



ABSTRACT

National Health Mission – State Health Society – Tamil Nadu – Upgradation of 9 Primary Health Centres by sanctioning of Human Resources under National Health Mission funds - Sanctioned - Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In Government Order first read above, orders were issued for the upgradation of 9 Primary Health Centres with sanction of funds Rs.216 lakhs for the execution of civil works through Public Works Department. Regarding Human Resources for the 9 Up Graded Primary Health Centres, directions were issued to send the proposal for Human Resources, on approval of funds for staff cost by Government of India.

2. In the letter second read above, the Mission Director, State Health Society has stated that, a detailed proposal for the Human Resource required for the Up Graded Primary Health Centres detailed below were included in Supplementary Programme Implementation Plan 2017-18. However, the approval have been issued in Supplementary Record of Proceedings 2017-18 for the post of Staff Nurses only. The post of Medical Officers and Supporting staff were not approved in Supplementary Record of Proceedings 2017-18.

3. The Mission Director, State Health Society has also stated that in respect of Radiographer for Up Graded Primary Health Centres, the post had not been approved in previous Record of Proceedings – 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18 and hence in Supplementary Record of Proceedings 2017-18. However, the posts are essential for implementing the upgradation of Primary Health Centres to render specialized services to rural public and public in remote area.

4. It is therefore proposed for sanction of below detailed posts for 9 Primary Health Centres, upgraded in the Government Order first read above, as in the case

of other Up Graded Primary Health Centres previously sanctioned under National Health Mission:-

5. As per National Rural Health Mission Guidelines, all posts should be on contract basis. However, during the sub group and National Programme Coordination Committee (NPCC) meeting, the State has informed that the Government of India that the post of Medical Officers and other Para Medical Staff / Clerical Staff shall be filled up on regular time scale of pay as per the State Government Policy and pay and allowances to the incumbents shall be drawn through the Treasury. The consolidated amount / contractual pay to staff budgeted under National Health Mission, will be remitted into the Treasury, for the staff in position, based on the details of staff position from the District Health Societies. This procedure is being followed in respect of all the Primary Health Centres so far upgraded under National Health Mission. Therefore the staff cost is indicated as per National Health Mission norms.

6. The above detailed posts are required for each of Up Graded Primary Health Centres as follows:

7. The Mission Director, State Health Society has therefore requested Government order in this regard.

8. After careful examination, the Government have decided to accept the proposal of Mission Director, State Health Society and accordingly issue the following orders:-

- i. Sanction is accorded to create the 27 post of Medical Officer in time scale of pay under the administrative control of Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine as follows:-

- iii. Sanction is accorded to create 9 post of Radiographer in time scale of pay under the administrative control of Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine as follows:-

The above staff shall be paid through Treasury and the Mission Director, State Health Society shall remit the amount approved under National Health Mission into the State Government account as per the existing procedure.

- iv. Sanction is accorded to create 27 Multipurpose Hospital Worker posts shall be filled up through Outsourcing, as per National Health Mission norms.

v. The Mission Director, National Health Mission is authorized to rationalise the posts of Staff Nurse as per the case load.

The Mission Director, State Health Society is permitted to remit the Contract payment approved by National Health Mission in respect of Staff sanctioned in para 8(ii) above and also Mission Director, National Health Mission is directed to remit the amount approved under National Health Mission in respect of Staff sanctioned in Para 8(i) 9(ii) (iv) above as and when approved in subsequent Programme Implementation Plan and also remit the following head of account.

11. The Mission Director, National Health Mission is directed to get approval in the subsequent Programme Implementation Plan in respect of the post mentioned in para 8 (i) (iii) & (iv) above.

12. The expenditure towards the staff cost of post sanctioned in para 8 (i) (ii) (iii) & (iv) above is an item of "New Instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine / The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is directed to apply for sanction of advance from

the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form A appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this orders. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is also requested to send a draft explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2018 – 2019 to Finance (BG.I) / Health-I) Department without fail.
