ORDER:

In the letters first and third read above, the Government of India has proposed to establish a Regional Institute of Para Medical Sciences (RIPS) at Coimbatore and informed that HLL Life care Ltd., a Government of India enterprise under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has been engaged as a project consultant for setting up the Regional Institute of Paramedical Sciences (RIPS) in Coimbatore and requested the Government of Tamil Nadu bidentify and allot 5.22 acres of land in Coimbatore Medical College for establishment of RIPS and to consent for the revised cost from Rs.150 to Rs.180 crores with Government of India and State Government share as 75:25.

2. In the letter fourth read above, the Government of Tamil Nadu has conveyed its consent to Government of India to allocate 5.22 acres of land in Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore and permit M/S HLL Life Care Limited for carrying out the construction of Regional Institute of Paramedical Sciences (RIPS) and to establish the proposed RIPS at Coimbatore at a revised cost restricted to Rs.150 crores with a revised ratio for the Central and State Government share as 75:25 subject to the conditions that the State Government share should not be increased further.

The Government of India has also been requested to bear the recurring cost of the RIPS for a period of 5 years post launch of the project by Government of India irrespective of plan or during the 13th plan rather than the current plan.

The Government have examined the case carefully and have decided to allocate 5.22 acres of land in Coimbatore Medical College to Regional Institute of Paramedical Science (RIPS) Coimbatore and permit M/S.HLL Life Care Limited for carrying out the construction of Regional Institute of Paramedical Science (RIPS) Coimbatore Accordingly, the Government accord permission to the Director of Medical Education to direct the Dean, Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore to earmark 5.22 acres of land in Coimbatore Medical College to Regional Institute of Paramedical Science (RIPS) Coimbatore and permit M/S HLL Life Care Limited for carrying out the construction of Regional Institute of Paramedical Sciences (RIPS).
 - 5. The Director of Medical Education is directed to take action accordingly.
