ORDER:

The Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has informed that the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) has approved for upgradation of Thanjavur Medical College, Thanjavur and Tirunelveli Medical College, Tirunelveli under Phase III of Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana at a cost of Rs. 150 crore each, of which the Government of India's share is Rs. 120 crore and the State Government's share is Rs. 30 crore.

2. Meanwhile, during the Budget Speech 2014-2015, the Hon'ble Minister for Finance and Public Works made the following announcement:-

"This Government will establish two more Super Speciality Hospitals with modern trauma care centres in the Medical College Hospitals of Thanjavur and Tirunelveli at a total cost of Rs. 300 crore"

3. Based on the Budget announcement of the Hon'ble Minister for Finance and Public Works, this Department has communicated to the Government of India concurrence, in-principle', for sanction of Rs.30 crore each to Thanjavur Medical College, Thanjavur and Tirunelveli Medical College, Tirunelveli as the State's share, for upgradation of the Institutions as Super Speciality Hospitals, in order to expedite the approval and funding for Government of India.

- 4. The Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Department informed that the civil works in the Government Medical Colleges / Institutions approved under Phase-III of Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana be taken up on priority basis and communicated the guidelines for conduct of preliminary gap analysis and submission of report thereof by the State Government. Accordingly, the Preliminary Gap Analysis Reports for upgradation of Thanjavur and Tirunelveli Medical Colleges under Phase-III Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana have been forwarded to Government of India and subsequently, the Detailed Project Reports also been forwarded to the Government of India for approval.
- 5. After detailed examination, the Government accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.30.00 crore (Rupees Thirty Crore only) each, as the State's proportionate share to Thanjavur Medical College and Tirunelveli Medical College, to complement the Government of India's share of Rs.120.00 crore each, for upgradation of the Medical Colleges under Phase-III of the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana Scheme (PMSSY) at Thanjavur and Tirunelveli.
- 6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

4210 Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health - 01 Urban Health Services -110 Hospitals and Dispensaries (including Pharmacy) Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan II State Plan JA - Buildings 16 Major Works. (DPC 4210 - 01 - 110 JA 1602)

- 7. After the project is approved by the Government of India, funds will be released at the appropriate time.
- 8. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.66593/Health-II/2014, dated: 08.12.2014.
