ORDER:

In Government Order third read above, permission was accorded to the Mayor Radhakrishnan Educational Society, Alagarkoil, Madurai to start B.Pharmacy course with an annual intake of 50 seats at Ananthapuram Village, Tenkasi Taluk, Nellai Kattabomman District from the academic year 1993-1994.

2. In Government Order fourth read above, permission was accorded to the Secretary, Sri Ram Nallamani Yadava Educational Society, Madurai for change of name from S. Chattanatha Kayaralar College of Pharmacy at Kodikurichi, Tenkasi Taluk, Tirunelveli District to Sri Ram Nallamani Yadava College of Pharmacy, Kodicurichi, Tenkasi, Tirunelveli District.

- 3. The Chairman and Managing Trustee, Sri Ram Nallamani Yadava Educational Institutions, Tenkasi, Tirunelveli District has requested the Government to grant permission to enhance the seats in B.Pharm course from 50 to 100 at Sri Ram Nallamani Yadava College of Pharmacy, Tenkasi, Tirunelveli District from the academic year 2019-2020.
- 4. In Government letter sixth read above, the Director of Medical Education was requested to conduct an inspection on the premises of the Trust for considering their request. Accordingly, the Director of Medical Education has constituted an inspection team to verify as to whether the proposed pharmacy college has fulfilled the conditions prescribed by the Government in the Government Orders first to second and fifth read above and as per the norms of the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi.
- 5. In his letter seventh read above, the Director of Medical Education has submitted the proposal stating that the said institution has fulfilled the norms prescribed by the Government as well as by the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi and recommended to grant permission to the Chairman and Managing Trustee, Sri Ram Nallamani Yadava Educational Institutions, Tenkasi, Tirunelveli District to enhance the seats in B.Pharm course from 50 to 100 at Sri Ram Nallamani Yadava College of Pharmacy, Tenkasi, Tirunelveli District from the academic year 2020-2021.
- 6. The Government examined the case in detail in the light of the Inspection Report and the recommendation of the Director of Medical Education and grant permission to the Chairman and Managing Trustee, Sri Ram Nallamani Yadava Educational Institutions, Tenkasi, Tirunelveli District to enhance the seats in B.Pharm course from 50 to 100 (fifty to hundred) at Sri Ram Nallamani Yadava College of Pharmacy in S.F. Nos.22, 23, 26 and 27 at Nallamani Nagar, Kodikurichi Village, Kodikurichi Panchayat, Tenkasi, Tirunelveli District 627 804 from the academic year 2020-2021, subject to fulfill the following specific conditions along with other general conditions laid down in G.O (Ms) No.148, Health and Family Welfare (PME) Department, dated: 24.04.2018 as applicable to this proposal before admitting the students:
 - i. The Trust should obtain building completion certificate from the competent authority. i.e. PWD Engineer.
 - ii. The Trust should obtain building plan approval from the Directorate of Town and Country Planning (DTCP) in the name of Sri Ram Nallamani Yadhava College of Pharmacy.
 - iii. The Trust should obtain Clearance Certificate from the Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board, Tirunelveli.

- iv. The Trust should renew the No Objection Certificate from the Fire and Rescue Services Department, Tenkasi from 12.04.2020.
- v. The Trust should obtain the affiliation from the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University to the above pharmacy institution.
- 7. The Director of Medical Education is directed to take necessary further action accordingly.
