ORDER:

During the Budget Session 2015-2016, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has announced, among others, on the floor of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly under rule 110 of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rules, that a new Government Medical College will be established in Pudukkottai District.

2. In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued for the establishment of new Government Medical College at Pudukkottai. In the Government order second read above, land measuring 51.42.0 hectares in S.No.789/10, 789/12 and 789/13 in Mullur Village, Pudukkottai Taluk and District has been allotted by the Revenue Department for the construction of buildings to the new Medical College and Hospital.

3. The Director of Medical Education has sent proposal for according administrative and financial sanction for construction of new Government Medical College and Hospital Buildings at Pudukkottai for a sum of Rs. 229.46 crore along with the plan and estimate prepared by the Engineer-in-Chief (Buildings) and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Chennai in the plinth area rates for the year 2015-2016. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) has proposed to construct Institution Buildings, Hospital Buildings and Residential Buildings. The Director of Medical Education has therefore requested the Government to accord administrative and financial sanction for the construction of various buildings to the new Government Medical College at Pudukkottai.

4. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.229.46 crore (Rupees two hundred and twenty nine crore and forty six lakh only) towards the construction of the following buildings (details mentioned in the annexure to this order) to the new Government Medical College at Pudukkottai:-

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

"4210 – Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01 – Urban Health Services – 110 Hospitals and Dispensaries (including Pharmacy) – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan II State Plan – JA Buildings – 16 Major Works".

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2015-2016 to Finance (Health II) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No. 70763/Health II/2015 dated 31.12.2015 and ASL No. 1763 (One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty Three).
