ORDER:

The Principal, Sri Ramachandra College of Nursing, Chennai has requested Government to grant permission for increase of seats from 30 to 60 seats in Post Basic B.Sc., (N) course from the academic year 2016-2017.

2. Based on the request, the Director of Medical Education has constituted an inspection team to verify as to whether the proposed College of Nursing has fulfilled the conditions prescribed by the Government and the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi for increase in annual intake of Post Basic B.Sc., (Nursing) course seats from 30 to 60. The Director of Medical Education has submitted proposal along with the inspection report/ Project Report along with her specific remarks to the Government and requested Government to issue necessary orders.

3. The Government have examined the case in detail in the light of the recommendation of the Inspection team and the Director of Medical Education and permit the Principal, Sri Ramachandra College of Nursing, Porur, Chennai to apply to the Indian Nursing Council for increase of seats from 30 to 60 seats in Post Basic B.Sc., (N) course from the academic year 2016-2017, subject to the following conditions:-

- (a) Admission of students shall be made as per the rules fixed by the Government from time to time.
- (b) Tuition fees including special fees should be collected from the students at the same rates as prescribed by the Government from time to time. The Management should also give separate undertaking

stating that NO CAPITATION FEE or any other fund in the name of building fund, etc. will be collected from the students seeking admission in the Private Self Financing Nursing Colleges.

- (c) The Trust should obtain recognition/suitability /affiliation from the Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council, Chennai, Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai respectively before admitting the students for the increased seats.
- (d) The Government have the right to utilize the Government Endowment fund created by the Trust in meeting the justifiable payment to students that may arise due to non-compliance of rules and regulations of the Government by the Trust like winding up of course without valid reasons, etc.
- (e) The Trust should not run any other Nursing Institution within 10 kms radius.
- (f) The trust should fulfill the teacher student ratio as per Indian Nursing Council norms.
- (g) The international Journals should be purchased.
- (h) Get the approval of the Indian Nursing Council for increase of seats from 30 to 60 in Post Basic B.Sc., (N) and the students should be admitted only after the approval is obtained.

4. The Director of Medical Education is requested to take necessary further action accordingly.
