From the Mission Director, State Health Society, Tamil Nadu, No.1360/SHS/S/2016, dated: 17.07.2017.

ORDER:

The Government of India have revised the Central and State share contribution of Grants in aid from the ratio 75:25 to 60:40 and stated that it is applicable from the financial year 2015-16.

2. The Mission Director, State Health Society has stated that various civil works were included in Programme Implementation Plan 2015-16 for strengthening of health facilities in the State. Among the proposed works, the Government of India has approved the following civil works in the Record of Proceedings 2015-16 and the budgetary allocations is provided, subject to additional resources becoming available due to increase in the State share:

3. The Mission Director, State Health Society has also stated that a proposal to authorize him to release the funds for schemes as and when funds are received from Government of India has been placed in the 29th Executive Committee meeting vide agenda No.6 and the same was approved.

- 4. The Mission Director, State Health Society has also stated that a sum of Rs.1764.50 lakh approved and released by National Programme of Co-ordination Committee in Record of Proceedings 2015-16, has been remitted to Government account.
- 5. The Mission Director, State Health Society has therefore requested the Government to issue orders in this regard.
- 6. After careful examination, Government have decided to accept the proposal of Mission Director, State Health Society and accordingly issue the following orders:-
 - (i) The Mission Director, State Health Society is permitted to execute the above civil works at the cost of Rs.1764.50 lakh against each of them through Public Works Department.
 - (ii) Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.1764.50 lakh for execution of works as in the annexure to this order.
 - (iii) The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai is permitted to issue orders to the Executive Engineers of the concerned Divisions for the drawal of funds.
 - (iv) The Mission Director, State Health Society is permitted to change the place of works and cost of works on the basis of local requirements, subject to condition that not to exceed the total cost approved.
- 7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited from the following head of account:-
 - " 4211-00 Capital Outlay on Family Welfare -103 Maternity and Child Health State's Expenditure AA– Civil works under National Health Mission Scheme 16 Major works". (DPC 4211-00-103-SA-1606)"
