In the Government order third read above, permission was accorded to the Director of Medical Education to take over the movable and immovable assets of the IRT-Perundurai Medical College and Hospital Erode and also requested to take over any asset which is left out in the order and presently in possession by the Management of the IRT- Perundurai Medical College and include the same to the Government account and to submit an actual report regarding taking over of the movable and immovable assets of IRT – Perundurai Medical College.

In the circumstances reported by the Director of Medical Education in his letter fourth read above, the Government permits the Director of Medical Education to increase the number of seats from 15 to 50 in Diploma in Medical Laboratory (DMLT) course at IRT Perundurai Medical College, Erode from the academic year 2019-2020, subject to the conditions that no new posts shall be created with any extra financial commitment to the Government and the mode of selection of the students for the said courses are through Selection Committee, Office of the Director of Medical Education, Chennai.
