ORDER:

The Managing Trustee, Gem Digestive Diseases Foundation, Coimbatore has requested Government to grant permission for increase in annual intake of seats from 50 to 60 in B.Sc., (Nursing) Course conducted in Gem Institute of Nursing Education and Research, Coimbatore.

- 2. The Director of Medical Education was requested to verify as to whether the College of Nursing has fulfilled the conditions prescribed by the Government and the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi for increase in annual intake of B.Sc., (Nursing) course from 50 to 60. The Director of Medical Education has submitted proposal along with the inspection report to the Government along with her specific recommendation on the desirability and feasibility for increase of seats from 50 to 60 in B.Sc., (Nursing) Course conducted at "Gem Institute of Nursing Education and Research" Coimbatore and requested necessary orders in this regard.
- 3. The Government have examined the case in detail in the light of the recommendation of the Inspection team and the Director of Medical Education and permit the Managing Trustee, Gem Digestive Diseases Foundation, Coimbatore to increase the annual intake of B.Sc., (Nursing) course from 50 seats to 60 seats at GEM Institute of Nursing Education and Research, Coimbatore from the academic year 2015-2016, subject to the following conditions:
 - (a) Admission of students shall be made as per the rules fixed by the Government from time to time.

- (b) Tuition fees including special fees should be collected from the students at the same rates as prescribed by the Government from time to time. The Management should also give separate undertaking stating that NO CAPITATION FEE or any other fund in the name of building fund, etc. will be collected from the students seeking admission in the Private Self Financing Nursing Colleges.
- (c) The Trust should obtain recognition/suitability /affiliation from the Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council, Chennai, Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai respectively before admitting the students for the increased seats.
- (d) The Government have the right to utilize the Government Endowment fund created by the Trust in meeting the justifiable payment to students that may arise due to non-compliance of rules and regulations of the Government by the Trust like winding of course without valid reasons, etc.
- (e) The Trust should not run any other Nursing Institution within 10 kms radius.
- 4. The Director of Medical Education is requested to take necessary further action accordingly.
