ORDER:-

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India has granted approval for upgradation of Thanjavur and Tirunelveli Medical Colleges under Phase-III Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana at a cost of Rs.150 crore each of which Government of India's share is Rs.120 crore and the State Government's share is Rs.30 crore.

2. The Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare have conveyed the sanction for the release of Project fund for upgradation of Thanjavur and Tirunelveli Medical Colleges under Phase-III Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana as follows:-

3. The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India has stated that as per clause 4.5 of the Memorandum of Agreement (MoU) with State Governments, State Government concerned shall release State share of Rs.30.00 crore for each of the Government Medical College Institutions in their State taken up for upgradation under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana Phase-III. It has now been decided that the State share would be utilized for procurement of Medical equipment for the Government Medical College Institutions.

- 4. The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India has appointed M/s. HITES, a Public Sector undertaking of the Ministry as Procurement Support Agency (PSA) for procurement of medical equipment for each of the Government Medical College Institutions. HITES would undertake entire procurement process for the Government Medical College Institutions, for and on behalf of the Ministry. The Ministry has also stated that presently HITES requires Rs.15.00 crore immediately for procurement of medical equipments for each of the Government Medical College Institutions concerned in the State.
- 5. In anticipation of approval from the Government of India, in the Government Order second cited, orders have been issued sanctioning a sum of Rs.30.00 crore each (Rupees Thirty crore only) as the State's proportionate share to Thanjavur Medical College, Thanjavur and Tirunelveli Medical College, Tirunelveli to complement the Government of India's share of Rs.120.00 crore each for upgradation of the Medical Colleges under Phase-III of the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana at Thanjavur and Tirunelveli and the same was not utilized.
- 6. The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India has requested this Government to release Rs.15.00 crore per Government Medical College Institution in the State to HITES so as to enable them to take up procurement process without any delay. HITES will open a separate account for each Government Medical College Institution and furnish the account details to this Government.
- 7. After detailed examination, the Government accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.30.00 crore (Rupees Thirty crore only) each, as the State's proportionate share to Thanjvur Medical College and Thirunelveli Medical College, to Complement the Government of India's share of Rs.120.00 crore each for upgradtion of the Medical Colleges under phase III of the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana Scheme (PMSSY) at Thanjavur and Tirunelveli and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.15.00 crore (Rupees Fifteen crore only) each towards purchase of equipment to the above Medical Colleges through M/s. HITES.
- 8. The Government also order that, the Government Order second read above shall be cancelled.
- 9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above shall be debited under the following head of account (Demand 19-03)
 - "2210 Medical and Public Health 05 Medical Education, Training and Research 105 Allopathy State's Expenditure JA Improvements to Medical College 19 Machinery and Equipments 01 Purchase. (DPC 2210 05 105 JA 1916)
- 10. Necessary additional funds of Rs.30.00 crore will be provided in the Final Modified Appropriation 2017-2018. Pending provision of such funds in Final Modified Appropriation 2017-2018, the Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 9 above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the legislature by Specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2017-2018. The Director of Medical Education is also requested to include this expenditure while sending the budget proposals for Final Modified Appropriation 2017-2018 and draft explanatory notes for

Supplementary Estimates 2017-2018 and draft explanatory notes for Supplementary Estimates 2017-2018 to Government in Finance (Health-II) Department without fail.

11. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.1638/Fin./Health-II/2018, dated 01.02.2018 and ASL No.2599 (Two thousand five hundred and ninety nine).
