#### **ORDER:**

During the Budget Speech 2019-20, among others made an announcement as follows:-

- "90. அனைத்து அரசு மருத்துவமனைகளிலும் அத்தியாவசிய மருந்துகள் தேவையான அளவு இருப்பு வைப்பதில், நாட்டிலேயே தமிழ்நாடு முன்னணியில் உள்ளது. அதேபோல், அனைத்து நிலை மருத்துவமனைகளிலும் முக்கிய உடற் பரிசோதனைகள் தொகுப்பாகக் கிடைப்பதை உறுதிசெய்யக்கூடிய முக்கியமான இலட்சியத் திட்டத்தை இந்த அரசு செயல்படுத்தும். இத்திட்டத்திற்குத் தேவையான உபகரணங்கள், கருவிகள் மற்றும் பொருட்கள் வழங்கப்படுவதுடன், இத்திட்டத்திற்கான சிகிச்சை நெறிமுறைகளும் உருவாக்கப்படும். இத்திட்டத்திற்கென மூன்று ஆண்டுகளில் 247 கோடி ரூபாய் செலவிடப்படும்".
- 2. In the letter read above, the Mission Director, National Health Mission has stated that the Drugs and Diagnostics are the two major contributors for Out-Of- Pocket Expenditure (OOPE) in any health systems. The Government of Tamil Nadu is providing free drugs at all the three levels of health institutions through an effective drug delivery supply chain management through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Ltd. As per the 71<sup>st</sup> NSSO analysis, Tamil Nadu is a leading State with minimal out of pocket expenditure for drugs in public facilities. To reduce Out-Of- Pocket Expenditure further and to provide quality care in parallel with free availability of drug services, it is essential to provide a comprehensive set of quality assured laboratory testing services at free of cost to all patients attending the Government Hospitals.
- 3. In order to implement the above services, a proposal at a total cost of Rs.273.14 Crores was prepared and 30 % of cost was proposed for the year 2019-20 in PIP 2019-20 and the Government of India has approved Rs.82.25 crores in RoP 2019-20 as follows:

- 4. The Mission Director, National Health Mission has further stated that, a proposal regarding Essential Diagnostics Services System was placed in the 37<sup>th</sup> EC meeting of State Health Society held on 11.02.2019 and the same has been approved by the Executive Committee vide Agenda No.8/37/2019 on 11.2.2019 and requested to issue necessary orders in this regard.
- 5. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Mission Director, National Health Mission and accordingly issue the following orders:-
  - (i) Sanction is accorded to implement the Essential Diagnostics Services System (EDSS) in all Primary, Secondary and Tertiary Healthcare Institutions in Tamil Nadu.
  - (ii) Sanction is accorded to create a State Programme Management Unit for Essential Diagnostics Service System in the National Health Mission, Tamilnadu as mentioned below:

- (iii) Sanction is accorded to create a District Programme Management Unit for Essential Diagnostics Services System (EDSS-DPMU) at the District Public Health Lab located in the District Head-quarters Hospitals concerned by providing certain infrastructure strengthening to the existing units as indicated below:

- ii) She/he will liaise with officers from each of the directorates for the implementation of the essential diagnostic services system
- (d) The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to place District IT-Coordinator (LIMS) @ 1 per district at 30 Districts Mentioned in annexure to this Government order at a salary of Rs.16,500/- per month on out sourcing basis through ELCOT.
- (iv) Sanction is accorded to constitute District Lab Technical Advisory Committee (DLTAC) to coordinate with Essential Diagnostics Services Systems District Programme Management Unit concerned as follows:

- (c) The District Lab Technical Advisory Committee and Essential Diagnostics Services Systems District Programme Management Unit shall meet at least once every 3 months.
- (v) Sanction is accorded to constitute an Expert Committee for creating a detailed implementation plan for the Essential Diagnostic Services System as follows:

- (vii) The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to designate one State Nodal Officer for each specialty viz., Pathology, Microbiology and Biochemistry from the Directorates, as an additional charge without any additional financial implications with the approval of the Executive committee of the State Health Society, Tamil Nadu.
- (viii) The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to develop the Lab Information and Management System with dedicated comprehensive web app-based Laboratory Information and Management System software in all the health facilities across Tamil Nadu such that it integrates smoothly with any HMIS and LIMS software in use in Government hospitals and complies with relevant quality standards through the agency hired by National Health Mission for implementation of HMIS / LMIS in the State.
- (ix) The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to procure and supply of necessary equipment such as computer, barcode printer, barcode reader, laser printer, etc., through the Managing Director, ELCOT, Chennai for implementation of the LIMS.
- (x) The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to establish a logistics system to interconnect all the laboratories throughout the State in a Hub-and-Spoke for the implementation of Essential Diagnostics Services System.
- (xi) The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to rationalize the Laboratory technician of various programmes to ensure adequate Human Resource, necessary for the implementation of Essential Diagnostics Services System with the concurrence of respective

- Project Directors/Mission Directors/Director of Medical Education/Director of Medical and Rural Health Services/Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine.
- (xii) The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to implement the scheme as a Pilot project in Thiruvallur District at an approximate cost of Rs.610.624 lakhs as mentioned in Annexure to this Government Order.
- (xiii) The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to incur the funds for the above Pilot project from the National Health Mission -RoP approved funds of 2019-20.
- (xiv) The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to utilize the necessary funds from National Health Mission RoP funds for miscellaneous activities such as Information Educational Communication, Supportive Supervision, Capacity building, Office Expenses, Monitoring and Evaluation, etc related to the implementation of Essential Diagnostics Services Systems.
- (xv) The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to submit detailed gap analysis for all districts for Sanction of the funds for the other districts.
