ORDER:

In the letter read above, the Director of Medical Education has sent the proposal for replacement of Co-60 Radioactive source for Theratron Phoenix Teletherapy Unit to Government Rajaji Hospital, Madurai.

2. The Director of Medical Education has stated that the Dean, Government Rajaji Hospital, Madurai has stated that the Theratron Phoenix Teletherapy Unit was purchased and installed during the year 2002 and the output of the unit at the time of installation was 200 RMM (295.57 cGy/min). By its nature, the Cobalt – 60 Radioactive source has decayed and the present output is 57-54 cGy/min and it is working in its third half life period and the source should not be used below the dose rate of 50cGy/min and therefore the Co-60 Radioactive source has to be replaced urgently to continue the treatment for the cancer patient without interruption. She has further stated that the replacement of Cobalt-60 Radioactive source is very much essential for giving treatment to poor Cancer patients and also to avoid hardship to the patients.

3. The Director of Medical Education has therefore requested the Government to accord necessary administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.1,04,50,000/- to replace Co-60 Radioactive source for Theratron Phoenix Teletherapy Unit to Government Rajaji Hospital, Madurai as detailed below:-

6. The Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and deposit the amount sanctioned in para 4 above to the Personal Deposit Account of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation, Chennai by means of Cheque / Demand Draft.
