ORDER:

During the Budget Speech 2014-2015, among others, the Government of India has announced that the National Centre of Ageing will be established in Chennai.

- 2. Based on the above announcement, the Government of India has conveyed administrative approval for a sum of Rs.126.87 crore (non-recurring Rs.97.75 crore and recurring cost Rs.29.12 crore) for setting up of a 'National Centre of Ageing' at Chennai.
- 3. Accordingly, the Director of Medical Education forwarded the detailed project report for establishment of National Centre of Ageing proposed at King Institute of Preventive Medicine, Guindy, Chennai and requested the Government of India to accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs. 97.75 crore towards Non-recurring expenditure (including cost of construction of building for Rs.78 crore) and Rs.28.50 crore towards recurring expenditure, for setting up of the said centre.
- 4. During the first meeting of the Project Monitoring Committee held in New Delhi on19.01.2016, under the Chairmanship of the Secretary, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi, a Memorandum of Understanding between the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India and the Government of Tamil Nadu and Madras Medical College, Chennai for setting up of 'National Centre of Ageing' was

signed. Further, the Government of India have also moved a proposal for release of an amount of Rs.10 crore to the Government of Tamil Nadu / the Grantee Institution.

5. The project involves setting up of 200 bedded hospital for elderly care with various speciality departments. This centre will also conduct specialized courses in Geriatric care and it involves Non-recurring and Recurring expenditure. The recurring expenditure comprises of Human Resources, Drugs and Consumables, etc., and non-recurring expenditure comprises of the following components:

i. Civil works - Rs.78.00 crore ii. Machinery and equipment - Rs.19.50 crore iii. Ambulance - Rs.00.25 lakhs.

6. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and accord administrative approval for Rs.97.75 crore towards the following items of non-recurring expenditure for setting up of a National Centre of Ageing in the premises of King Institute and Preventive Medicine, Guindy, Chennai under the aegis of Madras Medical College, Chennai and permit to utilize the initial provision of Rs.10.00 crores (Rupees Ten Crore only) and subsequent releases for the above purpose, as and when released by the Government of India:

i. Civil works
-Rs.78.00 crore (Rs.73.00 crore for the year 2014-2015 and Rs.78.00 crore for the year 2015-2016 by adding 7% for escalation of costs)

ii. Machinery and

equipment -Rs.19.50 crore

iii. Ambulance -Rs.00.25 lakhs.

Rs.97.75 crore

- 7. The recurring expenditure for this National Centre of Ageing will be issued separately after detailed examination.
