ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, National Quality Assurance Standards Programme (NQAS) has been implemented in the state in the Primary and Secondary care institutions (District Head Quarters Hospital / Sub District Hospital / Community Health Centre /Primary Health Centre and has shown progress in improving the Quality of care in these institutions. Now LaQshya programme is proposed to be implemented including Medical College Institutions for the first time in the state to improve the quality of services in Labour Room and Maternity Operation Theatre. To give guidance on the implementation at state level, a state mentoring group (SMG) is to be formed with the following members and a state nodal officer (SNO) is to be designated:-

Responsibilities of State Mentoring Group(SMG):

1. Identification of facilities for implementation.
2. Proposing funds for the program through state PIPs
3. Arrange for periodic training to various stakeholders.
4. Ensuring Baseline and periodic assessments done as per National Quality Assurance Standards Programme checklist and to monitor progress.
5. Visit the facilities every month for monitoring the implementation of activities as per LaQshya guidelines.
6. Coordinating with central Program Management Unit (PMU) of LaQshya periodically on the implementation status in the state and to make improvements.

The state nodal person will be responsible for overall coordination and progress of the program in the state.

Facility Quality circle has to be formed at department level with an informal group of the staff in Labour Room and Maternal Operation Theatre, to work closely to improve the Quality of Care in their respective department and to implement and monitor the activities as provided by guidelines.

- Ensuring Adherence to Protocols & Clinical guidelines.
- To conduct monthly meeting to monitor progress.
- Assessment of Labour room & operation theatre using the National Quality Assurance Standards Programme Departmental Checklists and Gap Analysis.
- Prioritisation and Action planning for closure of gaps as per 'Maternal and New-born Health Toolkit' and 'Guidelines for Standardisation of Labour Rooms at Delivery Points'.
- Management of 'Campaign' /'Rapid Improvement Cycle'.
- Collation of data elements, required for monitoring of quality Indicator
- Analysing and Periodic and regular reporting of Indicators to District Quality Assurance Unit.

3. The proposal has been included in the PIP and the Government of India has approved a sum of Rs. 135.05 lakhs for the year 2018-19 for the implementation of LaQshya program.
