National Health Mission – State Health Society – Tamil Nadu – Up scaling implementation of Population based Non Communicable Diseases Screening Program to all Universal Health Coverage blocks covering 35 blocks in 834 Health and Wellness Centres and the entire Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) covering 140 Urban Primary Health Centres – Sanctioned - Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

The Hon'ble Minister for Health and Family Welfare Department has announced on 14.6.2018 on the floor of Assembly that Up scaling of Population based Non Communicable Diseases Screening Program to all Universal Health Coverage blocks covering 35 blocks in 834 Health and Wellness Centres and the entire Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) covering 140 Urban Primary Health Centres will be implemented.

- 2. In Government Order first read above, orders were issued implementing the Population based Non Communicable Diseases Screening Program in five districts viz., Pudukottai, Perambalur, Krishnagiri (Phase I) and Ramanathapuram and Karur and 2 corporations Tirunelveli and Coimbatore (Phase II) by deploying 1203 field functionaries.
- 3. Under the program, guidelines have been issued to implement population or community based Non Communicable Diseases screening to enumerate all the eligible population in the community and make house-to-house visits to bring the eligible population under screening through a field functionary who could be an Accredited Social Health Activist (ASHA) / Women Health Volunteer (WHV) also known as Community Professional Health (CP-Health) outsourced via Tamil Nadu Corporation for Development of Women (TNCDW). The field functionary will make house—to-house visits and carries out enumeration, creation of awareness on Non Communicable Disease and risk factors, screen for Hypertension by using Digital Blood pressure monitor and for Diabetes Mellitus by Glucometer testing and motivates the target population for attending cancer screening services at the nearest Primary Health Care. They also keep a record of the Non Communicable Diseases patients already detected under the program for ensuring follow up for further investigations or treatment and also do group counseling and forms patient

support groups for various Non Communicable Diseases in the community. The field functionary is paid, performance based incentive and travel support

- 4. The State is now planning to transform its 985 sub-centres across 42 Health Unit Districts in the State to Health and Wellness Centres (HWCs) in the current year by selecting one block per Health Unit District. Among these, population based Non Communicable Disease screening program is already on-going in 7 blocks selected for Universal Health Coverage /Comprehensive Primary Health Care.
- 5. The above proposal to extend the Population based Non Communicable Disease program to all the other 35 Universal Health Coverage blocks covering 834 Sub-centres / Health and Wellness Centres for linking the Health and Wellness Centres activity with population based Non Communicable Disease screening through 834 new field functionaries has been included in the PIP 2018-19.
- 6. The total budget approved in the Record of Proceedings 2018-19 for the whole program including for the on-going activity is Rs.843.21 lakh for 2018-19.

- 7. The above proposal has been approved by the Executive Committee in its 35th meeting.
- 8. The Mission Director, National Health Mission has requested necessary orders in this regard.
- 9. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Mission Director, National Health Mission and order as follows:
 - i. The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to upscale the population based Non Communicable Disease Programme in the 35 blocks covering 834 Health and Wellness Centres (as detailed in Annexure –I) and 140 Urban Primary Health Centres (as detailed in Annexure-II) at a cost of Rs.461.50 lakh as detailed below.

- ii. The Mission Director is permitted to engage Women Health Volunteer / Community Professional Health (outsourced via Tamil Nadu Corporation for Development of Women) where ever required in the up-scaling of the program.
- iii. The Mission Director is permitted to train the Master trainers at each blocks and the field functionaries (Accredited Social Health Activist / Women Health Volunteer / Anganwadi Workers) through the Master trainers and

- iv. The Mission Director is permitted to procure one kit per Women Health Volunteer / Accredited Social Health Activist / Anganwadi Workers consisting of a Digital Blood Pressure Monitor, Glucometer and Glucostrips, lancets through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation fixed rate contract and also provide required logistic and financial support in terms of activity based incentives and travel allowances.
