1. It is certified that the Chengalpattu Medical College, Chengalpattu is recognized u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 for 50 MBBS seats and permitted to increase of MBBS seats from 50 to 100 under 10 (a) (i) of the IMC, Act 1956.

5. Full justification for instituting the MD (Forensic Medicine):

Dearth of qualified Post Graduate teachers in the Speciality in Tamil Nadu State.

The Dean, Chengalpattu Medical College, Chengalpattu has applied for starting of MD (Forensic Medicine) with an annual intake of 3 seats per year at Chengalpattu Medical College, Chengalpattu. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Tamil Nadu have decided to issue "Essentiality Certificate" to the applicant for the starting of MD (Forensic Medicine) with an annual intake of 3 seats per year at Chengalpattu Medical College, Chengalpattu from the academic year 2015-2016, subject to the condition that the approval of Medical Council of India / Government of India should be obtained before the students are admitted.

It is certified that:-

- (a) It is desirable to starting of MD (Forensic Medicine) with an annual intake of 3 seats per year in the public interest.
- (b) Starting of MD (Forensic Medicine) with an annual intake of 3 seats per year at Chengalpattu Medical College, Chengalpattu is feasible.
- (c) The institution in the said department is having adequate clinical material as per the Medical Council of India norms.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the course as per Medical Council of India norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the above said course at this College with the permission of the Central Government.
