ORDER:-

The Director of Medical Education has stated that initially in the year 1959, Madras Medical College Men's hostel building was established for the MBBS/BDS students for nearly 50-80 students per academic year. Every year student's admission for MBBS and BDS courses has gradually increased. Currently admission for first year MBBS is 250, first year BDS is 50, B.Pharm is 50 and for other para-medical allied subjects are 100 students. Nearly 450 students join the College every academic year. Every year, the number of candidates increase, but the building and infrastructure facilities have not adequately increased for the accommodation of the new students.

2. The Director of Medical Education has forwarded the rough cost estimate prepared by Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Chennai Region for the construction of Men's Hostel for Under Graduate (U.G.) students at Madras Medical College, Old Jail Compound, Chennai.

3. The Director of Medical Education has requested the Government to accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.28.85 crore for the year 2015-2016, for construction of Men's Hostel for U.G. students at Madras Medical College, Old Jail Compound, Chennai.

4. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.28,85,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Eight Crore and Eighty Five Lakh only) towards construction of Men's Hostel for U.G. students at Madras Medical College, Old Jail Compound, Chennai.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“4210-Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01-Urban Health Services – 110 – Hospital and Dispensaries (including Pharmacy) – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan- II State Plan – JA Buildings – 16 Major Works” (DPC:4210-01-110-JA-1602)”.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of “New Instrument of Service” and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by drawl of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BGI) Department directly in Form A appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finances (BGI) Department. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2015-2016 to Finance Department at the appropriate time without fail.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.10382/Health-II/2016, dated:13.02.2016 and ASL No.2356 (Two thousand three hundred and fifty six only).
