ORDER:

The Director of Medical Education in his letter sixth read above, has stated that the policy decision of the Government is "One Government Medical College in each district." At present, 20 Districts have 24 Government Medical Colleges including IRT Perundurai Medical College in Erode District. The districts of Thiruvallur, Cuddalore, Ariyalur, Perambalur, Namakkal, Ramanathapuram, Virudhunagar, Dindigul, Krishnagiri, Nagapattinam, Tirupur and the Nilgiris do not have any Government Medical College.

2. The Director of Medical Education has further stated that the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India has announced that the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs have given its approval to establish 75 additional Government Medical Colleges by 2021-22 attached with existing district/referral hospitals under phase-III of the ongoing Centrally Sponsored Scheme at a cost of Rs.325.00 crore per college. This cost will be shared in the ratio of 90:10 for North-Eastern States and Special Category States and 60:40 for remaining

States/UTs. The Government of India has, further, stated that the financial assistance will be provided for a new Medical College of 100 MBBS seats per annum. However, the States can consider the establishment of 150 seats intake with additional funding from their own resources, i.e. the Government of India is expected to provide 60% of Rs.325.00 crore (Rs.195.00 crore only). The remaining amount will have to be met by the State Government.

3. The Director of Medical Education has stated that based on the above announcement of the Government of India, the Government of Tamil Nadu has duly obtained approval of the Technical Evolution Committee of the Government of India and issued Essentiality Certificate for starting of new Government Medical College at Virudhunagar District.

4. In the Government Order third read above, orders have been issued for transfer of land measuring an extent of 9.08.5 Hectares, free of cost to Health and Family Welfare Department for establishment of New Government Medical College in Virudhunagar District. The details of survey number are as follows:-

5. In the Government order fourth read above, orders have been issued for starting of the New Medical College at Virudhunagar District and one post of Special Officer-cum-Dean to the above Institution has been sanctioned.

6. In the letter fifth read above, the Government of India has conveyed the approval of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare to the proposals for establishment of following six new Medical Colleges in the State of Tamil Nadu under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for "Establishment of new Medical Colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals (Phase III)" :-

In his letter sixth read above, the Director of Medical Education has requested the Government to issue necessary administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.380.00 crore for the year 2019-2020 for construction of buildings for starting a new Government Medical College and Hospital for admission of 150 MBBS students at Virudhunagar District.

He has countersigned and forwarded the Rough Cost Estimate prepared by the Engineer in Chief (Buildings) and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public works Department, Chennai for construction of New Government Medical College and Hospital, in Virudhunagar District. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs. 380.00 Crore and release a sum of Rs. 100.00 Crore (Rupees One Hundred crore only) for the year 2019-2020 for construction of buildings for starting a new Government Medical College and Hospital for admission of 150 MBBS students at Virudhunagar District. Balance amount will be released based on the requirement of funds.

10. The expenditure sanctioned in para 9 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

11. The Director of Medical Education is Estimating, reconciling and Controlling Authority for the new head of account at para 10 above.

12. The Pay and Accounts Officer/ Treasury Officers concerned are directed to open a new head of account.

13. The expenditure sanctioned in para 9 above shall constitute an item of "New Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. The Director of Medical Education is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2019-2020 to Finance (BG.I) Department at the appropriate time without fail. The expenditure shall be incurred only after inclusion of this sanction in the Supplementary Estimates and passing of the Supplementary Appropriation Act.
