

Planning and Development – Provision of Additional Wards and Equipments to Government Hospital, Tiruparankundram, Madurai District at cost of Rs.3.22 crores – Sanctioned – Orders – Issued.

#### Read:

- 1. G.O.(Ms).No.233, Health and Family Welfare (F1) Department, dated: 23.09.2016.
- 2. From the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services letter No.51428/P&D/4/2018, dated: 29.08.2018 and 06.09.2018.

#### ORDER:

In Government Orders first read above, orders have been issued among others upgrading the Primary Health Centre at Tiruparankundram into Government Taluk Hospital with 60 beds and also an amount Rs.51.00 lakhs has been sanctioned for construction of buildings and Rs.8.66 lakhs for equipments, linen and furniture.

- 2. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services has now stated that the construction of 60 bedded hospital has been carried out by demolishing old and depilated condition of staff quarters in the premises of Government Hospital. The construction works have been completed by the Public Works Department authorities for the ward and only for 20 beds and an amount Rs.51.00 lakh has been fully utilized for towards the same. The Chief Engineer, Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai has sought for additional funds of Rs.150.00 lakhs for construction of Building for 40 bedded wards.
- 3. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services has sent the Rough Cost Estimate of the Buildings, Equipments and has requested the Government to accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.3.22 crores (Rupees Three Crore and Twenty Two Lakhs only) towards construction of the remaining

40 bedded ward, at Government Taluk Hospital in Tiruparankundram in Madurai District and procurement of equipments for the above Hospital as indicated below:
