



ABSTRACT

National Health Mission - Establishment of the Pain and Palliative care Units in 17 Medical College Hospitals and Creation of 68 posts of Staff Nurses (Regular and Contract) and 34 posts of Palliative care Hospital Workers through outsourcing – Administrative Sanction - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Order 1st read above, among others, the Government have permitted the Mission Director, National Health Mission to establish the Pain and Palliative Care Units in the 10 Districts viz., Cuddalore, Dindigul, Krishnagiri, Namakkal, Ramanathapuram, Tiruvallur, Thoothukudi, Tiruppur, Tiruvarur and Thiruvannamalai districts from the funds approved under National Health Mission in the first phase.

2. In the Government Order 2nd read above, the Government have issued orders for establishment of 10 more Pain and Palliative Care units in District Headquarters Hospitals at Kanchipuram, Pollachi, Kallakurichi - Villupuram, Walajapet-Vellore, Kumbakonnam, Erode, Trichy, Salem, Tirunelveli and Kanniyakumari districts in phase II under National Health Mission.

3. In the Government Orders 3rd read above, the Government have issued orders for establishment of 12 more Palliative Care units in District Headquarters Hospitals at Ariyalur, Dharmapuri, Nagapattinam, Nilgris, Perambalur, Sivagangai, Theni, Virudhunagar, Thoracic Medicine Hospital, Thoppur at Madurai and in Medical College Hospitals at Karur and Pudukkottai and at Royapettah Government General Hospital, Chennai.

4. Now, the Mission Director, National Health Mission in his letter 4th read above, has stated that, in the RoP 2019-20, it has been approved to implement services under National Programme for Palliative Care as phase IV in 17 Medical College Hospitals viz., Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Stanley Government General Apex Hospital, Government Multi Super Speciality Hospital, Coimbatore Government General Apex Hospital, Dharmapuri Government General Apex Hospital, Chengalpet Government General Apex Hospital, Kanyakumari Government General Apex Hospital, Government Mohan Kumaramangalam Government General Apex Hospital, Sivagangai Government General Apex Hospital, Thanjavur Government General Apex Hospital, Theni Government General Apex Hospital, Thoothukudi Government General Apex Hospital, Tirunelveli Government General Apex Hospital, Trichy Government General Apex Hospital, Vellore Government General Apex Hospital, Villupuram Government General Apex Hospital and IRT Perundurai Government General Apex Hospital. He has further proposed to carry out the

repair and renovation works in the 17 Medical College Hospitals by calling for quotations locally at a cost of Rs. 255 lakh at the rate of Rs.15 lakh per institution. The Mission Director has also proposed to approve the Staff Pattern at Institution level as detailed below:

5. The Government have examined the proposal of the Mission Director, National Health Mission and decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:

- (i) The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to establish the Pain and Palliative Care Units in the 17 Medical College Hospitals from the budget approved in Record of Proceedings 2019-20 under National Health Mission as detailed below:-

- (ii) Sanction is accorded for creation of 23 (regular) posts of Staff Nurses for the above Pain and Palliative Care units in 17 MCHs in level 14 - Rs.36,000-1,14,000, out of total 68 posts, following in the ratio of 1:2 between regular and contract posts of Nurses as envisaged in G.O(Ms)No.400, Health and Family Welfare department, dated:16.12.2014, under the control of the Director of Medical Education as detailed in the annexure to this order.
- (iii) The Director of Medical Education is the cadre controlling authority of the above said 23 posts of Nurses and the Director of Medical Education is permitted to fillup the above said posts.
- (iv) The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to place the 45 posts of Staff Nurse on contract basis as per the National Health Mission norms through MRB at a cost of Rs.14,000/- per month with an annual increment of Rs.500/- every year till they are regularized and to incur the expenditure from the funds approved under National Health Mission.
- (v) The Mission Director, National Health Mission is directed to remit the salary component for Staff Nurse (Regular) into Government account as and when received from the Government of India by National Health Mission.
- (vi) The Dean concerned institutions have permitted to place the 34 posts of Palliative Care Hospital Worker on outsourcing through the District Health Society as per National Health Mission norms at a cost of Rs.6000/- p.m.
- (vii) Administrative approval is accorded to the Mission Director, National Health Mission to allot the funds for repair and renovation @ Rs.255 lakh for, 17 Medical College Hospitals to the concerned Dean of the Medical College Hospitals from the Record of Proceedings approval as per the National Health Mission norms.
- (viii) The Mission Director, National Health Mission and the Dean of the concerned Medical College Hospitals have directed to ensure that the contractual agreement between the outsourcing agency and State Health Society denies the opportunities of the employees to claim any right for absorption and inform that the outsourcing agency must be held responsible for any future litigation.
