ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued for the implementation of the Menstrual Hygiene Programme in Tamil Nadu for adolescent girls in rural areas, Postnatal Mothers delivered in Government Health Institutions and for Women prisoners. In the Government Order second read above, orders have been issued for the extension of the said Menstrual Hygiene Programme to the female inpatients in the Institute of Mental Health, Chennai.

2. The Hon'ble Chief Minister made an announcement on the floor of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly, under Rule 110 of Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rules during the Budget session 2020-2021 for the Extension of Menstrual Hygiene Scheme to Adolescent Girls in the Urban areas and to Women inpatients in Government Health Institutions as follows:-

"கிராமப்புற வளரிளம் பெண்களுக்கிடையே தன் சுத்தத்தை மாதவிடாய் கால தன் சுகாதாரத் திட்டம் செயல்படுத்தப்பட்டு வருகிறது. இந்த ரூபாய் செலவில் நகாப்புறத்தில் பயிலும் பள்ளி திட்டம் 37.47 கோடி மேலும், அனைத்து மாணவியர்களுக்கும் விரிவுபடுத்தப்படும். அரசு உள்நோயாளியாக சிகிச்சை பெறும் பெண்களுக்கும் மருத்துவமனைகளில் சானிடரி நாப்கின் வழங்கப்படும் (24.03.2020)"

- 3. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has sent proposal for the extension of Menstrual Hygiene Programme to Urban areas and scaling up of the said Scheme to Women inpatients in 781 Government Medical Institutions as detailed below:-
 - (a) to procure beltless sanitary napkins under Menstrual Hygiene Scheme to Adolescent girls in the age group of 10-19 age in Urban areas at a cost of Rs.3474 lakhs (Rupees Thirty Four Crore Seventy Four Lakhs only) through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited including Transportation Charges.
 - (b) to procure beltless sanitary napkins under Menstrual Hygiene Scheme to Women inpatients in Government Hospitals (24 MCH + 31 DHQ + 271 SDH + 423 UG PHC + 32 UCHC) at a cost of Rs.941.46 lakhs (Rupees Nine Crore Forty One Lakhs and Forty Six Thousand only) through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited including Transportation Charges.
 - (c) to deliver beltless sanitary napkin for adolescent girls in urban areas directly to Government Schools and indents and acknowledgement for the same to be obtained by the Urban Health Nurse. The Urban Health Nurse will go to ICDS centre on every Saturday and along with Anganwadi workers, they will distribute to girls who are not covered in the Government / Government aided schools.
 - (d) to deliver beltless sanitary napkin for women inpatients in Government Health Institutions in reproductive age group (20-49 years) similar to the sanitary napkin delivered to the postnatal mothers in Government facilities.
 - 4. The financial synopsis involved for implementation of the proposal given is as below:-

- 5. The Government examined the proposal of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine in detail and decided to accept the same. Accordingly the Government hereby approve the extension of Menstrual Hygiene Programme to adolescent Girls in the Urban areas and to women inpatients in Government Medical Institutions in the reproductive age group of 15-49 years. Accordingly, sanction is accorded for Rs.44,15,46,000/- (Rupees Forty four crore fifteen lakhs and forty six thousand only) for carrying out the Programme.
- 6. Further, the Government direct the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine to take action for procurement of napkins to adolescent Girls in the Urban areas and to women inpatients in Government Medical Institutions in the reproductive age group of 15-49 years through the Tamil Nadu Medical Service Corporation Limited. Further,
 - (i) The sanitary napkins shall be delivered directly to Government Schools and the indents and acknowledgement will be obtained by Urban Health Nurse as per the register maintained. The Urban Health Nurse will go to ICDS centre on every Saturday and along with Anganwadi worker they will distribute to girls who are not covered in the Government Schools. The Urban Health Nurse will distribute the napkins to the postnatal mothers during the home visits.
 - (ii) The acknowledgment of receipt of sanitary napkin has to be obtained in the register to be maintained for this purpose for adolescent girls / delivered women at the HSC / ICDS / School Centre.
