ORDER:

The Director of Medical Education in his letter read above, has stated that the Engineer-in-Chief (Buildings) and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department, Chennai has stated that the Dean, Rajiv Gandhi Government Hospital, Chennai has requested to evolve Plan & Estimate for the proposed new block for infectious Disease and Respiratory Emergency and Critical care facility at Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai. He has also stated that the proposed building may be built by demolishing the existing ward 12 A and ward 4, which are in dilapidated condition. He has requested the Public Works Department authorities to prepare Rough Cost Estimate for the construction of new Block for Infectious Disease and Respiratory Emergency and Critical care facility at Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai. Accordingly, the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region has prepared the Rough Cost Estimate, with plinth area of 7759.00 sq.m. of Ground floor + Seven Floors, with accommodation details and necessary provisions, which works out to Rs.27.83 crore for the year 2017-2018, duly countersigned by the Director of Medical Education.

2. The Director of Medical Education has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.27.83 crore for the year 2017-2018 for construction of new block for Infectious Disease and Respiratory Emergency and Critical care facility at Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai, with plinth area of 7759.00 sq.m. of Ground floor + Seven Floors.

3. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of Director of Medical Education in detail and accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.27.05 crore (Rupees Twenty Seven crore and Five lakh only) for construction of new Block for Infectious Disease and Respiratory Emergency and Critical Care Facility at Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following Head of account:- [Demand No. 39.02]

"4210.Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01.Urban Health Services – 110. Hospitals and Dispensaries (Including Pharmacy) - State's Expenditure – JA. Buildings – 16. Major Works. (DPC 4210 01 110 JA 1602)".

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to the Finance (BG.I) Department directly, in Form-A appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963, along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from the Finance (BG.I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2018-2019 to the Finance (BG.I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.58055/Health-II/2018, dated 20.11.2018 and ASL No.1989 (One thousand nine hundred and eighty nine).
