ORDER:

The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that a separate and exclusive helpline, along with existing 104 helpline with round the clock counseling facility for addressing the management of Depression/Stress Management, prevention of suicides and also reattempts is essential to prevent the increasing number of suicide cases in the State. One of the intermediate indicators proposed by the World Bank is Establishment of suicide hotline. Towards these goals, as apart of second year activity, 104 Health helpline was expanded with additional 10 desks and additional 20 psychologists so as to establish Depression / Stress management hotline.

2. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has furnished the recurring cost of the salary of 20 psychologists and operational cost of additional 10 desks for the Depression / Stress management hotline with linkage to the 104 Health Helpline which was established in Government Order first read above is detailed below:-

3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has requested the orders of the Government on the followings:

- i. To sanction an amount of Rs.73,20,000/- (Rupees Seventy Three Lakh and Twenty Thousand only) to the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System

Reform Program towards recurring of the salary of psychologists and operational cost of additional 10 desks for the Depression / Stress management hotline.

- ii. To authorize the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program to draw and disburse the above sanctioned amount.

4. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program have decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:-

- i. Sanction is accorded for a sum of recurring expenditure of Rs.73,20,000/- (Rupees Seventy Three Lakh and Twenty Thousand only) to the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program towards the salary of psychologists and operational cost of additional 10 desks for the Depression / Stress management hotline.
- ii. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned at para 4 (i) above.
- iii. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4(i) above shall be debited to the following head of account:-
