### **ORDER:-**

The Director of Medical Education has stated that the first floor of the Madras Medical College has been utilised as Administrative Office for the College and the staff of the college and allied institutions have all crossed 40 years of age and it is a very strenuous job for all of them to climb up, since the height of the floor is nearly 100 feet and they have to climb 40 steep steps. Moreover, there are about 5600 students are studying in various courses starting from Certificate Course to Super Specialty courses in the College. It is imperative to have a lift, for the safety of the health condition of office staff, Associate Professors / Professors and Directors of various institutions attached to the College. The erection of lift car of size 2.35 m x 2.95 m with a capacity to transport minimum of 8 persons at a time is very much needed for the welfare of the staff.

2. The Director of Medical Education has forwarded the rough cost estimate prepared by the Superintending Engineer, Public Works Department, Building (C&M), Chepauk, Chennai for construction of lift well, supply and erection of lift and connected electrical works in Madras Medical College, Chennai for an amount of Rs.28,30,000/- for the year 2014-2015 and Rs.30,13,000/- for the year 2015-2016.

3. The Director of Medical Education has therefore, requested the Government to accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.28,30,000/- for the year 2014-2015 and Rs.30,13,000/- for the year 2015-2016 for construction of Lift Well, supply and erection of Lift and connected electrical works in Madras Medical College, Chennai.

4. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.30,13,000/- for the year 2015-2016 assuming an escalation of 10%, for construction of lift well, supply and erection of lift and connected electrical works in Madras Medical College, Chennai for the welfare of the staff, students and the patients as detailed below:-

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“4210-Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health - 01-Urban Health Services - 110 - Hospital and Dispensaries (including Pharmacy) - Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan- II State Plan - JA Buildings - 16 Major Works” (D.P. Code 4210-01-110-JA-1602)”.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of “New Instrument of Service” and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BGI) Department directly in Form A appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BGI) Department. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2015-2016 to Finance Health-II Department at the appropriate time without fail.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.8384/Health-II/2016, dated:12.02.2016 and ASL No.2304 (Two Thousand Three Hundred and Four).
