ORDER :

The Director of Medical Education in his letter fifth read above, has stated that a policy decision of the Government is "One Government Medical College in each District." At present, 20 Districts have 24 Government Medical Colleges including IRT Perundurai Medical College in Erode District. The Districts of Thiruvallur, Cuddalore, Ariyalur, Perambalur, Namakkal, Ramanathapuram, Virudhunagar, Dindigul, Krishnagiri, Nagapattinam, Tirupur and the Nilgiris do not have any Government Medical College.

2. The Director of Medical Education has also stated that the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India has announced that "the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs have given its approval to establish 75 additional Government Medical Colleges by 2021-2022 attached with existing district/referral hospitals under Phase-III of the ongoing Centrally Sponsored Scheme at a cost of Rs.325.00 crore per College. This cost will be shared in the ratio of 90:10 for North-Eastern States and special category States and 60:40 for remaining States/Union Territories. The Government of India also specified in the Memorandum of Understanding that on approval of the scheme by the Government of India, the State Government should submit the application form under Section 10A

of the Indian Medical Council Act. Further, the financial assistance will be provided for a new Government Medical College of 100 MBBS seats per annum. However, the States can consider the establishment of 150 seats intake with additional funding from their own resources, i.e. the Government of India is expected to provide 60% of Rs.325.00 crore (Rs.195.00 crore only). The remaining amount will have to be met by the State Government”.

3. The Director of Medical Education has further stated that based on the above announcement, the Government of Tamil Nadu has requested the Government of India, among others, for starting of one new Government Medical College at Krishnagiri District. Further, as per the guidelines prescribed by the Government of India for this purpose, a Detailed Project Report has also been prepared by collecting the details relating to land from the District Collector and the estimates prepared by the Public Works Department authorities. The report has been sent to Government of India for considering this Government's request for starting of a New Government Medical College at Krishnagiri District”.

4. In the Government letter second read above, based on the above announcement of the Government of India, the Government of Tamil Nadu has duly obtained approval of the Technical Evaluation Committee of the Government of India and issued Essentiality Certificate for starting of new Government Medical College at Krishnagiri District.

5. The Director of Medical Education has also stated that the Technical Evaluation Committee on 18.11.2019, among others, have approved the proposal of the Government of Tamil Nadu for starting of a new Government Medical College at Krishnagiri District.

6. In the Government order third read above, orders have been issued for transfer of Land to Health and Family Welfare Department for establishment of a new Government Medical College in Pollupalli Village, Krishnagiri Taluk and District, at free of cost measuring an extent of 10.12.0 Hectares with a survey No.338/1.

7. In the letter fourth read above, the Government of India has conveyed the approval of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare Department for establishment of the following three new Government Medical Colleges in the State of Tamil Nadu under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme attached with existing district/referral hospitals (Phase III):-

8. In the letter fifth read above, the Director of Medical Education has requested the Government to issue necessary administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.338.95 crore for the year 2019-2020 for construction of buildings for

new Government Medical College and Hospital for admission of 150 MBBS students at Krishnagiri District. The details of buildings and the cost involved are as follows:-

The required funds for this purpose are as follows: -

10. In the Government Order sixth read above, orders have been issued for the establishment of a new Government Medical College in Krishnagiri District and sanctioning one post of Special Officer-cum-Dean to the above Institution.

11. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.338.95 crore and release for a sum of Rs.70.00 crore (Rupees seventy crore

only) for the year 2019-2020 for construction of buildings (details mentioned in the annexure to this order) for starting a new Government Medical College and Hospital for admission of 150 MBBS students in Krishnagiri District. The balance amount will be released based on the requirement of funds.

12. The expenditure sanctioned in para 11 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:- [19-03]

13. The expenditure sanctioned in para 11 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. The Director of Medical Education is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2019-2020 to Finance (BG.I) Department at the appropriate time without fail. The expenditure shall be incurred only after inclusion of this sanction in the Supplementary Estimates and passing of the Supplementary Appropriation Act.
