#### ORDER:-

In continuation of the Government order read above, Government have decided to direct the Additional Director of Medical Education / Secretary, Selection Committee to sanction the following sitting allowances and other perquisites to Hon'ble Justice Thiru. A. Selvam (Retired), High Court of Madras, who has been appointed as Chairman for the Committee for identifying the remote, difficult and rural areas for the purpose of awarding incentive marks to the in-service Medical Officers for getting admission in the Post Graduate Degree Courses from the academic year 2019-2020 and to incur the expenditure from the Personal Deposit Account of the Director of Medical Education being maintained by the Additional Director of Medical Education / Secretary, Selection Committee as detailed below:-

- I. A sitting fees of Rs.10,000/- per day (Rupees Ten thousand only), subject to a maximum of Rs. 1,50,000/- per month (Rupees One lakh and fifty thousand only), (in lieu of salary).
- II. Travelling Allowance, Daily Allowance and Sumptuary Allowance as admissible to the Serving Judges of the High Court, Madras.
- III. Rent free furnished accommodation or House Rent allowance as per orders in force.
- IV. The Chairman of the Committee is entitled to medical facilities of Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS); if CGHS is not available, medical facilities as available to the Cabinet Ministers.

2. The Director of Medical Education is also directed to submit a report on the actual expenditure with the audited certificates of the Accountant General, Tamil Nadu, to the Government.
