ORDER:

The Mission Director, State Health Society has stated that the Muscular Dystrophy denotes a group of inherited disease due to chromosomal deficiency and gene disorder characterized by progressive weakness of the body and skeletal muscles that is responsible for the movements of the body. Every muscle in the Human body contain a variety of muscle proteins which are required for the structural and functional activity of muscle cells. These proteins are either absent or inadequate in people affected with muscular dystrophy syndrome. It results in progressive death of the muscle and immobility. There are about 46 varieties of Muscular dystrophy syndrome, which makes people wheel chair bound. Respiratory failure and ultimate death are the final outcome of this disease. There is no cure and no treatment is yet evolved to contain this dreaded disease. He has further stated that a meeting was convened on 28.06.2018 at National Health Mission of State level Expert Committee for the welfare of the Muscular dystrophy patients. Dr.N.Vijayakumar, State President (Tamil Nadu), Indian Association of Muscular dystrophy, Karur has suggested the constitution of the Expert Committee with the specialties consisting of Neurologist, General Medicine, Obstetrician & Gynecologist, Cardiologist, Physical Medicine specialties, Ayush Doctors, Pediatrician, Representatives from various department Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine, Director of Medical Education, Director of Medical and Rural Health Services, Social Welfare Department, Labour Department & Education Department, SSA, Paramedical Staffs 1 or 2 caregivers / Parent of Child with Muscular dystrophy and also suggested various welfare measures for the muscular dystrophy patients and the same was approved in the minutes of the meeting.

- The Existing Facilities in DEIC to be utilized for the Diagnosis and Rehabilitation of Children affected with Muscular Dystrophy.
- For Adults the Physiotherapy Department along with the Specialists available in the District Hospital / Medical College Hospital will deliver the services.

- District Mental Health team will Co-ordinate with the above mentioned for Psychological counseling.
