ORDER:-

The Director of Medical Education has reported that as per the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi, which is the Governing body of pharmacy education and the Tamil Nadu Dr.MGR Medical University, Chennai, a Pharmacology Department with qualified Pharmacy Staff is essential for conducting B.Pharm and M.Pharm course. Since Pharmacology is an important subject of the B.Pharm curriculum and since there is P.G course in Pharmacology being conducted in Madras Medical College, Chennai, it is appropriate that a separate department of Pharmacology for pharmacy be created with a separate Professor of Pharmacology qualified in Pharmacy.

2. The Director of Medical Education has therefore requested the Government to create one post of Professor in the pay band of Rs.15600-39100+ G.P.6600 in the discipline of Pharmacology, Madras Medical College, Chennai to teach B.Pharm and M.Pharm students in the Institute of Madras Medical College, Chennai.

3. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and accord sanction to create one post of Professor in the time scale of pay of Rs.15600-39100+G.P.6600 in the discipline of Pharmacology, Madras Medical College, Chennai at an annual average recurring cost of Rs.8,90,160/-(Rupees Eight Lakhs Ninety Thousand One Hundred and Sixty only).

4. The expenditure sanctioned for the post in para 3 above, shall be debited to the following head of account:

“2210 –Medical and Public Health 05- Medical Education, Training and Research 105 – Allopathy - I Non- Plan - AA – Chennai Medical College, Chennai – 01 Salaries.
(D.P.C 2210 – 05 – 105- AA- 0103).”

5. The Necessary funds will be provided in the FMA 2014-15. Pending provision of funds in FMA 2014-15, the Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para-3 above. The Director of Medical Education is requested to include this expenditure while sending the budget proposals for FMA 2014-15 to Government in Finance department without fail.
