ORDER:-

The Director of Medical Education, in the letter read above, has sent the proposal for conversion of one Unit of General Surgery Department into Minimal Access Surgery Unit at Mahatma Gandhi Memorial Government Hospital, Trichy for better services to the poor ailing patients.

- 2. The Director of Medical Education has requested the Government to accord necessary permission to create a separate unit i.e. Minimal Access Surgery Unit under the Department of General Surgery with one Associate Professor and one Assistant Professor already sanctioned to the Department of General Surgery at Mahatma Gandhi Memorial Government Hospital, Trichy. She has stated that one post of Assistant Professor now available in the General Surgery Department may be redeployed for starting of Minimal Access Surgery Unit, in Mahathma Gandhi Memorial Government Hospital, Trichy. She has also stated that the renewal for both Under Graduate and Post Graduate of General Surgery Department for Medical Council of India recognition will not be affected due to the redeployment of the above posts.
- 3. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the request of the Director of Medical Education. Accordingly, the Government accord permission to create a separate unit i.e. Minimal Access Surgery Unit under the Department of General Surgery, with one Associate Professor and one Assistant Professor already sanctioned to the Department of General Surgery at Mahatma Gandhi Memorial Government Hospital, Trichy, subject to the condition that all the posts needed, in future, for this unit be filled up only through redeployment and equipment, required if any, should be met from the Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme funds.
