ORDER :

The Hon'ble Minister (Health and Family Welfare) has made an announcement on the floor of Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly that National Tobacco Control Programme will be extended to five more Districts namely Pudukottai, Cuddalore, Nagapattinam, Tiruppur and Tirunelveli at a total cost of Rs.25 lakh.

2. The National Tobacco Control Programme is being implemented in Kancheepuram & Villupuram Districts on pilot basis, since 2008 and in Government order 1st read above orders were issued extending the National Tobacco Control Programme in three more Districts namely Coimbatore, Madurai and Tiruchirappalli.

3. The National Tobacco Control Programme is implemented by the following three tier structure:

- a. National Tobacco Control Cell
- b. State Tobacco Control Cell (STCC) and
- c. District Tobacco Control Cell (DTCC)

4. The staffing pattern of State Tobacco Control Cell and District Tobacco Control Cell are as follows:

State Tobacco Control Cell

- i. State Consultant – National Tobacco Control Programme
- ii. Legal Consultant – State
- iii. Programme Assistant
- iv. Data Entry Operator

District Tobacco Control Cell

- i. District consultant – National Tobacco Control Programme
- ii. Psychologist & counselor
- iii. Social Worker
- iv. Data Entry Operator

5. A proposal for implementation of National Tobacco Control Programme in five more districts was included in Programme Implementation Plan 2017-18 and the same was approved in Record of Proceedings 2017-18.

6. In the letters 2nd read above, the Mission Director, State Health Society has stated that the proposal to extend National Tobacco Control Programme in five more Districts namely Pudukottai, Cuddalore, Nagapattinam, Tiruppur and Tirunelveli was placed in the 33rd Executive Committee meeting vide agenda No.42 and the same was approved.

7. The Mission Director, State Health Society has therefore requested Government order in this regard.

8. After careful examination, the Government has decided to accept the proposal of the Mission Director, National Health Mission and accordingly issue the following orders:-

- i. the Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to implement the National Tobacco Control Programme in 5 more Districts namely Pudukottai, Cuddalore, Nagapattinam, Tiruppur and Tirunelveli under National Health Mission fund.
- ii. the Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to create the following posts on contract basis to above said five Districts under National Tobacco Control Programme.

Sl. No.	Designation	Salary to be paid	Total No. of posts for five districts	Qualification
1.	District Consultant	35,000/-	5	Post Graduate in Public Health / Social worker or Management from a recognized university.
2.	Social Workers	13,000/-	5	Post Graduate in Sociology / Social work with 2 years of field experience.
3.	Psychologist	13,000/-	5	Post Graduate in Psychology /MSW or graduate in Psychology trained in counseling with 2 years of experience in the field of counseling services.
4.	District Data Entry Operator	10,000/-	5	Any Graduate with computer knowledge.

- iii. the Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to fill up the above post by selection committee through the advertisement in

- newspaper as per Government of India's guidelines as was done for the pilot Districts.
- iv. the Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to increase the 5% remuneration after completion of one year with continuous service based on performance assessment by the competent authorities.
- v. the Mission Director, State Health Society is directed to ensure that the terms and conditions as per the civil appeal No.979 of 2014, arising out of SLP (c) No.26090 of 2011 are duly followed in the contractual appointments.
