ORDER:

In the letter read above, the Director of Medical Education has stated that Dean, Stanley Medical College, Chennai has informed that there is no separate building for the Department of Forensic Medicine. At present, this Department is temporarily accommodated in the portion of Administrative Block, which is very old and lack of space and amenities. The total plinth area of the building required for the Department of Forensic Medicine as per Medical Council of India norms is 2130 Sq.m. The Dean, Government Stanley Medical College, Chennai has, therefore, requested the Engineer-in-Chief (Building) and Chief Engineer (Building), Chennai Region, Public Works Department to prepare the rough cost estimate for the construction of building to the Department of Forensic Medicine at Government Stanley Medical College, Chennai. Accordingly, the Chief Architect, Public Works Department, has prepared the drawings for Ground + 3 floors. The estimate for the above construction is prepared based on the plinth area rates for the year 2016-2017 pertaining to Chennai city, approved by the Chief Engineer (Building) and countersigned by the Director of Medical Education. The estimate cost works out to Rs.6.00 Crore for the year 2016-2017 and Rs. 6.60 crore for the year 2017-2018 considering an escalation of rates as 10% with the following accommodation details:-

- 2. The Director of Medical Education has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.6.00 crore for the year 2016-2017 and Rs.6.60 crore for the year 2017-2018 by adding 10% escalation charges for the construction of building to the Department of Forensic Medicine, at Government Stanley Medical College, Chennai.
- 3. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and accord necessary administrative and financial sanction for the construction of building to the Department of Forensic Medicine at Government Stanley Medical College, Chennai at a cost of Rs.5,83,53,000/- for the year 2017-2018.
- 4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"4210.Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01.Urban Health Services – 110. Hospitals and Dispensaries (Including Pharmacy) - State's Expenditure – JA. Buildings – 16. Major Works (D.P.C 4210-01-110-JA-1602)".

- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in para-3 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Director of Medical Education is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG.I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G.I) Department. The Director of Medical Education is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2017-2018 to Finance (B.G.I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
- 6. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.9505/Health–II/2018, dated: 23.02.2018 and ASL No.2804 (Two thousand eight hundred and four).
