ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, the Government have accorded administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.75.00 Crore towards the construction of Speciality Tower Block at Government Stanley Hospital, Chennai.

2. In his letter second read above, the Director of Medical Education has stated that the above said construction work was commenced on 15th October, 2015 and it was completed during January, 2017. But the building needs certain additional amenities such as additional Gas outlets, Furniture, Provision for HD Camera, LCD Monitor, Audio Visual Systems, CCTV Security Surveillance System, Provision of Rain Water Harvest Pits, Effluent Treat Plant, Additional A.C. facility and Electrical Fittings. Hence, he has forwarded the rough cost estimate prepared by the Chief Engineer (Buildings) duly countersigned by him for additional amenities to the Speciality Tower Block at Government Stanley Hospital, Chennai at a cost of Rs.14.19 crore for the year 2017-2018.

3. The Director of Medical Education has, therefore, requested the Government to accord necessary administrative and financial sanction for provision of additional amenities to the Speciality Tower Block at Government Stanley Hospital, Chennai at a cost of Rs.14.19 crore for the year 2017-2018.

4. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.9.92 crore (Rupees Nine crore and Ninety Two lakh only) for additional amenities to the Speciality Tower Block in Government Stanley Hospital, Chennai.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"4210.Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01.Urban Health Services – 110. Hospitals and Dispensaries (Including Pharmacy) - State's Expenditure – JA. Buildings – 16. Major Works (D.P.C 4210-01-110-JA-1602)".

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to the Finance (BG.I) Department directly, in Form A appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963, along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from the Finance (BG.I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department is directed to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2017-2018 to the Finance (BG.I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.11755/Health-II/2018, dated: 12.03.2018 and ASL No.2953 (Two thousand nine hundred and fifty three).
