#### ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, certain new posts viz Reader / Professor and Tutor / Assistant Professor were created for the new Medical Colleges started in the State. In the said Government Order, it has been clarified that if the sufficient faculties are not available either by promotion or by direct recruitment, the posts shall be filled up on contract basis with consolidated pay.

2. In the Government Order second read above, the Government have issued orders permitting the Director of Medical Education to fill up 25% of the vacancies in the post of Reader/Professor in all Government Medical Colleges on a consolidated pay, in addition to pension, by following the procedure prescribed in G.O.(Ms).No.333, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 28.09.2004.

3. In the Government Order third read above, the Government have enhanced the consolidated pay of retired Professors in Radiology Department from Rs.35,000/- to Rs.50,000/- per month with effect from the date of issue of the Order.

4. In the G.O.fourth read above, orders were issued raising the consolidated amount of Rs.70,000/- per month to the retired faculties appointed on contract basis besides pension for a period of five years under the control of Director of Medical Education in the following specialities in the clinical and non-clinical areas, irrespective of the different ranges of amount already paid to them.

**CLINICAL SIDE:**

1. Radiotherapy
2. Radio Diagnosis

In her letter fifth read above, the Director of Medical Education has stated that certain Medical Officers who have resigned from Government Service has requested for reappointment either on regular or on contract basis and hence she has requested the Government to give guidelines with regard to contract appointment as per the G.O. fourth read above for appointment Medical Officers who are retired voluntarily / resigned from Government service who are appointed on contract basis as Readers / Associate Professors in all Government Medical Colleges in a consolidated pay. Further, in her letter sixth read above the Director of Medical Education has sated among others that as per the Medical Council of India norms, any Medical Officer may be posted on contract basis up to the age of 70 years. Hence, she has requested the Government to issue necessary orders permitting the retired faculties appointed on contract basis up to the age of 70 years instead of five years besides pension.

6. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education carefully and independently by taking into account of the General Rule 11 of Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services and decided to permit the Director of Medical Education to fill up the 25% of vacancies in the specialities mentioned in the G.O. fourth read above up to the age of 70 years on contract basis with a consolidated amount of Rs.70,000/- per month besides pension with the retired / voluntarily retired / resigned Medical Officers, where the faculties are not available. The Government accordingly, do and hereby direct that the Director of Medical Education be permitted to fill up the 25% of vacancies in the specialities mentioned in the G.O. fourth read above, up to the age of 70 years on contract basis with a consolidated amount of Rs.70,000/- per month besides pension with the retired / voluntarily retired / resigned Medical Officers where the faculties are not available subject to the following conditions.

- a) In case of the Medical Officers who is voluntarily retired from Service, the consolidated pay for new appointment plus the pension drawn is not higher than the pay for individual, if he / she had continued in service.
- b) In case of resigned Medical Officers, the individual has not drawing pension / other benefits from the Government.

The Government further directed the Director of Medical Education to follow the procedures prescribed in G.O.first read above while making appointment on contract basis.
