The Principal cum Managing Trustee, Devaki Surgical Clinic, Allied Medical Science Centre, Karaikudi, Sivagangai District has requested the Government to grant permission for upgradation of CMLT Course into Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT) Course of two years duration at Devaki Surgical Clinic, Allied Medical Science Centre, Karaikudi with an annual intake of 15 students.

- 2. The Director of Medical Education has forwarded the project report of the above Trust along with the Inspection Report / compliance verification report to the Government and stated that the institution has complied with rectification of all deficiencies pointed out by Government and forwarded the request of the Trust for upgradation of CMLT Course into DMLT Course of two years duration at Devaki Surgical Clinic, Allied Medical Science Centre, Karaikudi with an annual intake of 15 students for orders.
- 3. The Government have examined the case in detail in the light of the project report, Inspection Report / compliance verification report and the remarks of the Director of Medical Education and grant permission to the above trust for the upgradation of CMLT course into DMLT course of two years duration at the Devaki Surgical Clinic, Allied Medical Science Centre, Karaikudi, Sivagangai District with an annual intake of 15 students from the academic year 2015-16, subject to the following conditions:-

- a) Admission of students shall be made as per the rules framed by the Government from time to time.
- b) Tuition fees including special fees should be collected from the students at the same rates as prescribed by the Government from time to time. The Trust should also give a separate undertaking to the effect that NO CAPITATION FEE or any other fund in the name of building fund, etc. will be collected from the students seeking admission in the said course.
- c) The Trust should obtain recognition from the King Institute of Preventive Medicine and Research, Guindy, Chennai-32 before admitting the students.
- 4. The Director of Medical Education is requested to take necessary further action in this matter.
