The Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy has requested the Government to provide a sum of Rs.4,90,000/-(Rupees Four lakh ninety thousand only) in the Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16 towards meeting the above mentioned expenditure as Rs,60,000/- has already been provided in BE 2015-2016.
- 3. The Government have examined the proposal of the Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy and have decided to accept the same and accord sanction additional amount of Rs.4,90,000/- (Rupees Four lakh and ninety thousand only) [(Rs.5,50,000/-) (Rs.60,000/-) = Rs.4,90,000/-] to the Government Unani Medical College towards visitation fee for Central Council of Indian Medicine and other allied expenditure.
