ORDER:-

Based on the orders issued in Government Order first read above in respect of Allopathy Medicine, in the Government Orders second and third read above orders were issued in respect of Medical students under Indian Medicine and Homeopathy, fixing the rate of stipend to the Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship Trainees (CRRIs) and Non-service Post Graduate Medical students as follows, with an automatic yearly increase of Rs.300/- to Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internees (CRRIs) and Rs.600/- to Non-service Post Graduate students with effect from 1.7.2009.

2. In the Government Order fourth read above orders have been issued, among others, revising the stipend with effect from 1.4.2014 to the Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internees / Non Service Post Graduate in respect of Medical students under Allopathy as follows with an automatic increase of Rs.400/- for Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internees (CRRIs) and Rs.700/- for Post Graduate / Higher Speciality student every year.

The Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy has stated that in Government Order fourth read above, the expenditure is debitible in the Head of Account which pertains to Allopathy only and there is no mention of Indian System of Medicine Colleges and that duration of both allopathy as well as Indian System of Medicine courses are one and the same and the Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internees (CRRIs) and Non Service Post Graduate students of Indian System of Medicine were so far getting their stipend on par with that of their counter parts in allopathy and requested the Government to sanction the enhanced rate of stipend as on 1.4.2014 for the Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internees (CRRIs) / Non Service Post Graduate Indian Systems of Medicine students in the related Head of Account on par with Allopathy side and to sanction Rs.6,95,52,000/- (Rupees Six Crores Ninety Five Lakhs and Fifty Two Thousand only) for the same.

4. The Government have examined the proposal of the Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy and decided to increase the stipend for Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internees (CRRIs) / Non Service Post Graduate students of Indian Systems of Medicine & Homoeopathy on par with that of their counter parts in allopathy, w.e.f. 1.4.2014 as follows, with an automatic increase of Rs.400/- for Compulsory Rotatory Residential Interness (CRRi) and Rs.700/- for Post Graduate students every year.

5. The Government have also sanctioned an additional amount of Rs.5,26,32,000/- (Rupees Five Crores twenty six lakhs and thirty two thousand only) towards payment of stipend to Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internees (CRRIs) / Non Service Post Graduate Students of Indian Systems of Medicine.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in paras 4 & 5 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the contingency fund, orders regarding which will be issued by Finance (BG-I) Department. The Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy is directed to send application in the prescribed form along with the copy of this order to Finance (BG-I) Department for sanctioning the advance for the required quantum. The Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy is also directed to send necessary note for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate for 2014-2015 for obtaining the approval of the Legislature at the appropriate stage.
