ORDER:-

In the letter first read above, the Deputy Registrar General (Medical Certification of Cause of Deaths), office of the Registrar General India, Government of India has been accorded sanction for creation of one post of Nosologist (Medical Statistician) for the office of the Chief Registrar of Births and Deaths, Tamil Nadu in the Pay scale of Rs.15,600 – 39,100 with Grade pay of Rs.5,400 with the central assistance provided under the plan scheme "Central Assistance to States for creation of the post of Nosologist (Medical Statistician)". The services of a full time Nosologist (Medical Statistician) are absolutely essential for the close monitoring and Supervision of Compulsory Production of Medical Certification of Cause of Deaths

- 2. In the letter third read above, the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has requested the Government to permit him to appoint the Nosologist from the cadre of Medical Officers of Primary Health Centres with requisite qualification and experience in Analytical Epidemiology (Preferably with MPH/M.Sc in Epidemiology) and get him / her trained in Medical Coding conducted by the Central Bureau of Health Intelligence, New Delhi before induction as Nosologist (Medical Statistician) duly following the guidelines of the Registrar General India. If no suitable/willing candidate is available, to fill up the post from the open market through Medical Recruitment Board.
- 3. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine and accorded sanction for the creation of one post of Nosologist (Medical Statistician) in the scale of pay of Rs.15,600 39,100 + G.P.5,400 in the office of the Chief Registrar of Birth and

Death, Tamil Nadu. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is permitted to appoint the Nosologist as suggested in para 2 above, duly following the guidelines of the Registrar General India, annexed to the Government of India's letter first read above.

4. The salary of the above post shall be debited to the following new head of account opened under Demand No.19 HOD:04

2210 Medical and Public Health – 80 General – 004 Health Statistics and Evaluation – III Centrally Sponsored Scheme – SA Medical Statistician – 01 Salaries. (DPC:2210-80-004 3A 0108)

- 5. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling authority for the above new head of account. The Pay and Accounts Officer / Treasury Officer concerned is requested to open the new head of account in their books. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is requested to send necessary proposal for provision of funds under the above head of account after filling up of the said post.
