ORDER:

The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services in his letter eighth read above, has sent detailed proposals to Government to accord administrative and financial sanction for implementation of extension of District Mental Health Programme in Nine (9) Districts viz. Villupuram, Pudukottai, Tiruppur, Sivagangai, Thoothukudi, Karur, Dindigul, Thiruvannamalai and Tirunelveli.

2. In the letter sixth read above, the Government of India has released the Central Grant of Rs.433.08 lakh for implementation of District Mental Health Programme.

- 3. The Government have examined the proposal of Director of Medical and Rural Health Services and accord administrative and financial sanction for implementation of District Mental Health Programme in Nine (9) Districts viz. Villupuram, Pudukottai, Tiruppur, Sivagangai, Thoothukudi, Karur, Dindigul, Thiruvannamalai and Tirunelveli at a total cost of Rs.433.08 lakh (Rupees four hundred and thirty three lakh and eight thousand only).
 - 4. The Government also issue the following orders:
 - i. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is permitted to utilize the funds allocated to each District of Villupuram, Pudukottai, Tiruppur, Sivagangai Thoothukudi, Karur, Dindigul, Thiruvannamalai and Tirunelveli towards incurring the items of expenditure in the first year of the Programme in 2014-2015 and in 2015-16 as detailed in Annexure-II to this order.
 - ii. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is permitted to transfer the earmarked amount sanctioned towards equipments and drugs to the Personal Deposit Account of the Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation for the supply of equipments and drugs to the above said 9 Districts.
- iii. Sanction is accorded for the creation of the posts on consolidated pay noted against each for each districts as detailed in Annexure-I to this order.
- iv. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is nominated as controlling and monitoring authority of the programme for the Nine Districts of Villupuram, Pudukottai, Tiruppur, Sivagangai, Thoothukudi, Karur, Dindigul, Thiruvannamalai and Tirunelyeli Districts.
- v. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is permitted to carry over the Training and Information Education and Communication (I.E.C.), activities through the concerned Joint Directors of Health Services in Co-ordination with the State Nodal Officer of the Programme and to direct the Deans of the Medical Colleges to depute their Psychiatric Professors on the request of State Nodal Officers/Joint Directors of Health Services to impart training/Information Education and Communication Activities as and when required.
- vi. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is permitted to constitute a District Level Committee under the Chairmanship of District Collector with the member as already laid down in the Government Order 3rd read above and also to authorize the Collector of the concerned Districts to form and register a society in each district for executing the programme as below:
