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#### ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, the Government have accorded administrative sanction for constitution of 51 Special Magistrate Courts with civil powers in various districts to try petty cases in 3 phases from the year 2017-2018 to 2019-2020 i.e., 17 courts in each phase. Orders were also issued therein by according financial sanction for a sum of Rs.9,47,76,360/- for the constitution of 17 Special Magistrate Courts in the first phase for the year 2017-2018 with the posts and other requirements. In the Government order second read above, the nomenclature of the above Special Magistrate Courts have been changed as District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Courts. Further, in the Government order third read above, orders were issued, by sanctioning 5 additional posts for 19 District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Courts including the 17 District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Courts sanctioned in the first phase.

- 2. In the Government order fourth read above, orders were issued for constitution of 17 District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Courts at 17 Taluks in various Districts of the State in the second phase for the year 2018-2019 with posts and other requirements.
- 3. Subsequently, the Deputy Registrar (Admn-III), High Court of Madras in his letter fifth read above, has requested the Government to issue necessary orders for constitution of the remaining 14 District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Courts at 14 Taluks where no courts are functioning in Phase-III for the year 2019-2020.
- 4. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras and accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.6,29,03,960/- [Rs.6,11,68,960/- as recurring expenditure and Rs.17,35,000/- as non recurring expenditure] and also sanction a sum of Rs.1,19,89,000/- (Rupees one crore nineteen lakh eighty nine thousand only) for the year 2021-2022 towards constitution of 5 District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Courts by sanctioning 85 new posts and other infrastructure facilities at the following 5 Taluks in various Districts of the State in the third phase for the year 2021-2022.

- 6. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is requested to send necessary draft notifications to the Government for its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, under the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 [Central Act III of 1873] and Code of Criminal Procedure 1973 for the commencement of the above said courts.

The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2021-2022 to Finance (Home-II) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
