ORDER:

The Hon'ble Chief Minister on the floor of the Legislative Assembly during the budget session for the year 2022-2023 in respect of the Forensic Sciences Department, among other things, has made the following announcement:-

2. In the Government Order first read above, the Government have accorded administrative sanction for up-gradation of Regional Forensic Science Laboratories at Madurai, Thanjavur and Vellore, as per the requirements of ISO/IEC 17025:2017 standards at a cost of Rs.2,85,41,000/- as detailed below:

In the Government Order second read above, the Government have accorded financial sanction for a sum of Rs.3,50,000/- from and out the administrative amount of Rs.285.41 lakh accorded in Government Order first read above and to release an amount of Rs.2,10,000/- for the financial year 2022-2023.

3. The Director(i/c), Forensic Sciences Department, Chennai, in his letter third read above, has stated that the bidder who quoted lowest price viz., M/S Perkin Elmer (India) Pvt.Ltd., Chennai-113, has been selected after due Tender process by the purchase committee, has offered to supply three (3) units of 'Gas Chromatograph-Mass Spectrometer' instrument at a cost of Rs.2,64,31,410/- including GST at 18 percent. The Director(i/c), Forensic Sciences Department, Chennai has requested to accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.2,76,22,410/- (i.e.,Rs.2,64,31,410/- for purchase of three (3) units of sophisticated 'Gas Chromatograph-Mass Spectrometer' instrument and Rs.11,91,000/- for purchase of Certified Reference Materials) towards up-gradation of Regional Forensic Science Laboratories at Madurai, Thanjavur and Vellore, as per the requirements of ISO/IEC 17025:2017 standards.

4. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director(i/c), Forensic Sciences Department, Chennai and decided to accept the same. Accordingly, Government accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.2,76,22,410/- (i.e.,Rs.2,64,31,410/- for purchase of three (3) units of sophisticated 'Gas Chromatograph-Mass Spectrometer' instrument and

Rs.11,91,000/- for purchase of Certified Reference Materials) towards upgradation of Regional Forensic Science Laboratories at Madurai, Thanjavur and Vellore, as per the requirements of ISO/IEC 17025:2017 standards.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para-4 above, shall be debited under the following heads of account:-
