### ORDER

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued, among others, for sanction of a District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court at Thirukuvalai in Nagapattinam District with posts and other requirements.

2. Pursuant to this, the Registrar General, High Court of Madras, has sent draft notifications under sections 4 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873) for the purpose of constitution of the District Munsif Court at Thirukuvalai in Nagapattinam District with a request to publish the same in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

3. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras, have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government direct that the following Notifications shall be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Extraordinary:-

### NOTIFICATION-I.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the first paragraph of section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of

1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby alters the number of District Munsifs to be appointed under the said Act for Nagapattinam District as eight with effect from the date on which the District Munsif, assumes charge of the District Munsif's Court at Thirukuvalai.

NOTIFICATION – II.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the second paragraph of section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after consultation with the High Court, Madras, hereby fixes the number of District Munsif to be appointed for the District Munsif's Court at Thirukuvalai in Nagapattinam District as one with effect from the date on which the District Munsif assumes charge of that Court.

NOTIFICATION – III.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby directs that, in the District of Nagapattinam, the Subordinate Judge's Court at Nagapattinam shall have and exercise original jurisdiction over the District Munsif's Court at Thirukuvalai, in addition to the existing jurisdiction with effect from the date on which the District Munsif assumes charge of the District Munsif's Court at Thirukuvalai.


