#### ORDER:

The Registrar General, High Court of Madras, in his letter read above, has stated that the High Court, after considering the request of the Principal District Judge, Salem, recommends the proposal for constitution of an Additional District Court at Attur in Salem District. In this regard, he has stated that out of the cases pending on the file of the existing Principal District Court, I Additional District Court, II Additional District Court and Special District Court for MCOP cases in Salem District as on 31.12.2020, 354 cases including 132 Original Suits and 29 Appeal Suits are arising from the territorial jurisdiction of the proposed Additional District Court at Attur in Salem District. The aforesaid pendency of cases arising from the territorial jurisdiction of Attur justifies the necessity for constitution of an Additional District Court at Attur.

- 2. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras has, therefore, requested the Government to issue orders for constitution of an Additional District Court at Attur in Salem District with requisite posts and other requirements.
- 3. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government order for constitution of an Additional District Court at Attur in Salem District at a total expenditure of Rs.1,39,40,320/- (Rupees one crore thirty nine lakh forty thousand three hundred and twenty only) [viz. Rs.1,22,37,320/- as recurring expenditure and Rs.17,03,000/- as non recurring expenditure] by sanctioning the following 15 new posts and other infrastructure facilities.

- 4. The Director of Stationery and Printing, Chennai is directed to supply stationery articles, requisite forms and registers to the above said court at free of cost against the specific indent of the Judicial officer concerned.
- 5. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is requested to send necessary draft notification to the Government for its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, under the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 [Central Act III of 1873] for the commencement of the above said court.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

- 7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature shall be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the contingency fund. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the contingency fund to the Finance (BG-I)

Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the contingency fund will be issued by the Finance (BG-I) Department. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2021-2022 at the appropriate time without fail.
