ORDER:

The Hon'ble Minister for Law, Courts and Prisons, while moving the Demand for Grants relating to Administration of Justice (Demand No.3), has made, among others, the following Announcement on the Floor of the Assembly on 09.07.2019:-

"Constitution of five new District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Courts at Karimangalam in Dharmapuri District, Vikravandi in Villupuram District, Singampunari in Sivagangai District, Pallavaram in Kancheepuram District and Maduravoyal in Tiruvallur District each at a cost of Rs.75.00 lakh"

- 2. Based on the above Announcement, the Registrar General, High Court of Madras, has sent proposal wherein he has stated that the High Court in consultation with the Principal District Judge, Kancheepuram District at Chengalpattu has decided to constitute a District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court at Pallavaram in Kancheepuram District (now in Chengalpattu District).
- 3. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras has, therefore, requested the Government to issue orders for the constitution of a District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court at Pallavaram in Kancheepuram District (now in Chengalpattu District) with requisite posts and other requirements.

4. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras, have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government order for the constitution of a District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court at Pallavaram in Kancheepuram District (now in Chengalpattu District) with the following posts:-

- 7. The Director of Stationery and Printing, Chennai is requested to supply 2 Tamil Typewriters and 2 English Typewriters and other stationery items at free of cost for the proposed constitution of the District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court at Pallavaram.

9. The expenditure sanctioned in paras 4 and 6 above shall constitute an item of "New instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the contingency fund. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is requested to calculate the actual amount required for the period up to next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the contingency fund to the Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from the Finance (BG-I) Department. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes to the Government in Finance (BG-I/Home-II) Department for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2019-2020 at the appropriate time without fail.

- 10. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is requested to send necessary draft notifications to the Government for its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, under the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 [Central Act III of 1873] and Code of Criminal Procedure 1973 for the commencement of the above said court.
- 11. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its C.No.8578/Home-II/2020, dated 28.2.2020 and U.O.No.12084/CMPC/2020, dated 10.3.2020 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.3165 (Three Thousand one hundred and sixty five).
