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## ORDER

The Minister for Law, Courts and Prisons, while moving the Demand for Grants relating to Administration of Justice (Demand No.3) for the year 2020-2021, had made, among others, the following Announcement on the Floor of the Assembly on 20.03.2020:-

“Constitution of an Additional District Court Arakkonam in Ranipet District”.

2. The Registrar-General, High Court of Madras, in the letter first read above, has stated that the High Court, after considering the request of the Bar Association, Arakkonam, Vellore District and in consultation with the Principal District Judge, Vellore has decided to constitute an Additional District Court at Arakkonam (formerly in Vellore District) in Ranipet District. He had furnished the statement showing the pendency of various category of cases as on 31.03.2020 on the file of the existing Principal District Court, Vellore, Additional District Court, Vellore, Additional District Court (FTC), Vellore and II Additional District and Sessions Court, Vellore at Ranipet, and the cases arising from the jurisdiction of Arakkonam as detailed below:-

The aforesaid pendency of cases in the existing Principal District Court, Vellore, I Additional District Court, Vellore, Additional District Court (FTC), Vellore and II Additional District and Sessions Court, Vellore at Ranipet justifies the need for the constitution of an Additional District Court at Arakkonam.

3. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary orders for the constitution of an Additional District Court at Arakkonam (formerly in Vellore District) in Ranipet District with posts and other requirements (other than the Laptop and Laser Printer Duplex).

4. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras, have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government accord sanction for constitution of an Additional District Court at Arakkonam in Vellore Judicial District by sanctioning 15 new posts and other infrastructure facilities at a total expenditure of Rs.1,56,00,272/- (Rupees One crore fifty six lakh two hundred and seventy two only) [viz. Rs.1,39,68,272/- as recurring expenditure and Rs.16,32,000/- as non-recurring expenditure] as detailed below:-

5. The Director of Stationery and Printing, Chennai is directed to supply one Tamil Typewriter and one English Typewriter, other stationery articles, requisite forms and registers to the above said court at free of cost against the specific indent of the Judicial officer concerned.

6. The Registrar-General, High Court of Madras is requested to send necessary draft notification to the Government for its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, under the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 [Central Act III of 1873] for the commencement of judicial work in the above said court.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course of time by an inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period up to next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras shall also send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2022-2023 to Finance (BG-I/Home-II) Department at the appropriate time, without fail.

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
