ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have sanctioned risk allowance at the rate of Rs.20/- per month to the Junior Reporters and Senior Reporters of Shorthand Bureau and the same was enhanced from Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- p.m. in Government order second read above and again enhanced at the rate of Rs.50/- p.m. and Rs.100/- p.m. in the Government orders third and fourth read above, respectively.

- 2. The Director General of Police / Head of Police Force in the letter fifth read above has stated that, in the present scenario, the duties of the Reporters of Police Shorthand Bureau in State Headquarters and in Districts/Cities have been increased manifold and they have to travel long distance for coverage of public meeting / Demonstration / fasting etc., organized by various political parties, caste and communal out of which involve huge risk while performing their duties and that too during odd hours.
- 3. The Director General of Police / Head of Police Force has therefore requested the Government to issue orders sanctioning a sum of Rs.13,71,600/- per annum (Rupees Thirteen Lakh Seventy One thousand and Six Hundred only) for the enhancement of Risk allowance from

Rs.100/- to Rs.1000/- per month to the Police Shorthand Bureau Staff from the rank of Junior Reporter to Senior Chief Reporters on par with Police personnel.

- 4. After detailed examination of the proposal of the Director General of Police, the Government hereby accord sanction for enhancement of the Risk Allowance payable to the Reporters in Police Shorthand Bureau (i.e., from the rank of Junior Reporters to Senior Chief Reporter) from Rs.100/- p.m. to Rs.200/- p.m. The details of posts and their respective enhanced rates and expenditure involved are given in the annexure to this order.
- 5. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department, vide its U.O.No.14029/Home-1/2022, Dated 21.03.2022.
