### **ORDER:-**

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has made the following announcement during the Golden Jubilee celebration of Women Police Force of Tamil Nadu on 17.03.2023 :-

2. Pursuant to the above announcement, the Director General of Police/Head of Police Force, Chennai in the letter read above has stated that there are 241 All Women Police Stations functioning in the State of Tamil Nadu. The All Women Police Stations are the grass-root level police organization to deal with the Public and they form cutting edge level of Police force. The All Women Police Stations are staffed by Women Inspectors or Women Sub-Inspectors, Women Head Constables and Women Police Constables. The effectiveness of the Police force depends upon the performance of the Police personnel at the Police Station level. In this recent past, the Government of India have announced a Scheme of identifying the Best Police Stations at the National level. Similarly, the State Government have implemented the

scheme of identifying the best Police Station at the State Level vide their G.O.(Ms).No.2350, Home (Police-14) Department, dated 28.11.2018 and awarding "Tamil Nadu Chief Minister's Trophy for Best Police Station" every year. The Director General of Police has therefore proposed to award one best All Women Police Station from across the State by awarding Trophies every year which will encourage every Police Personnel on Zone/City/Districts to work more efficiently towards reducing the cases and improved performance of other activities.

3. The Director General of Police/Head of Police Force, Chennai has also furnished the details of Trophies to be awarded for every year as detailed below:-

The Director General of Police/Head of Police Force, Chennai has therefore requested to issue necessary orders to institute "Kalaingar Police Trophy" for outstanding work rendered by "Women Police Personnel in All Women Police Stations" at a recurring expenditure of Rs.87,000/- (Rupees eighty seven thousand only) for 13 trophies.

The Government after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Director General of Police/Head of Police Force, Chennai to institute "Kalaingar Police Trophy" for outstanding work rendered by "Women Police Personnel in All Women Police Stations" at a recurring expenditure of Rs.87,000/- (Rupees eighty seven thousand only) for 13 trophies.

7. The Director General of Police/ Head of Police Force, Chennai is directed to send the parameters and rules governing the award of the Trophy, selection process and constitution of committee to Government for approval.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 6 above shall be met under the following Head of Account:-
