



## **ABSTRACT**

Police – Announcement made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister – Recruitment of Fishermen youth as Home guards for assisting the Coastal Security Group – Orders – Issued.

### **ORDER:-**

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has made the following Announcement on the floor of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly during the Police Demand [Demand No.22] on 13.09.2021:-

**“கடலோர பாதுகாப்பு காவல் படையினருடன் இணைந்து பணி புரிய 1000 மீனவ இளைஞர்கள் ஊர்க்காவல் படையினராக பணியமர்த்தப்படுவர். இதற்கான மொத்த தொடர் செலவு ரூபாய் 3 கோடியே 40 இலட்சம் ஆகும்”**

2. The Director General of Police/Head of the Police Force in the letter read above has stated that the Coastal Security Group is looking after security of coastal border of 13 Coastal districts through sea patrolling by boats and land patrol through beats and all terrain vehicles. Due to shortage of sanctioned strength in Coastal Security Group, certain number of home guards were sought from each coastal district to assist the Marine Police Station personnel for performing Coastal Security Group

duties such as patrolling, coordinating with fishermen community, village vigilance committee meetings, rescue operations etc. To alleviate shortage of manpower the Inspector General of Police, home guards has sent a consolidated proposal based on the announcement of Hon'ble Chief Minister for sanction of 1000 additional home guards for Coastal Security Group along with financial implication involved therefor.

3. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director General of Police. Earlier, the expenditure pertaining to Home guards was shared between Government of India and State Government in the ratio of 25:75. Now, the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India in their letter F.No.II-29012/2/2019-CD-172-210, dated 17.01.2020 has revised the reimbursement policy for Home guards and financial assistance by way of reimbursement has been discontinued from the financial year 2020-21. Hence, it is now proposed to implement this scheme with State funds and to recruit 1000 fishermen youth as Home guards in a phased manner over a period of 3 to 4 years with an initial recruitment of 300 fishermen youth as Home Guards and further recruitment be made based on the result of the initial recruitment in the Coastal Security Group activities. The Director General of Police has therefore submitted a revised proposal for initial recruitment of 300 fishermen youth as Home Guards for assisting Coastal Security Group at an expenditure of Rs.1,14,52,500/-.

4. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director General of Police have decided to accept the same. Accordingly, the Government accord sanction for recruitment of 300 fishermen youth as Home Guards for assisting the Coastal Security Group as detailed below:-

7. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph-5 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course of time by an inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023. Pending approval of the Legislature,

the expenditure may be initially met by drawl of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Director General of Police/Commissioner of Police is requested to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as an advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG.I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Director General of Police/Commissioner of Police shall also send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2022-2023 to Finance (Home-I/BG-I) Department without fail.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.18768/Home-I/2022, dated 20.04.2022 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.55 (Fifty five).
