Courts – Civil – Announcement made by the Hon'ble Minister for Law on the floor of the Assembly – Constitution of a Sub Court at Bodinayakanur in Theni District – Orders – Issued.

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ORDER:

The Registrar General, High Court of Madras in his letters read above, has stated that the High Court, after considering the request of the Bar Association, Bodinayakanur and in consultation with the Principal District Judge, Theni recommends the proposal for constitution of a Sub Court at Bodinayakanur in Theni District. In this regard, he has stated that out of the 4393 cases pending on the file of the existing Sub Court, Theni and Uthamapalayam as on 30.11.2019, 564 cases including 219 Original Suits, 8 MCOPs, 3 EIOPs, 144 HMOPs, 12 CMAs, 73 AS, 11 IPs, 74 EPs, 15 Ops and 4 Sessions cases are arising from the territorial jurisdiction of the proposed Sub Court, Bodinayakanur. The total number of 564 cases reveals the need for constitution of Sub Court at Bodinayakanur in Theni District.

2. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary orders for constitution of a Sub court at Bodinayakanur in Theni District with posts and other requirements. He has also requested the Government for the attachment of the Copyist Establishment and Nazir Establishment now functioning at the District Munsif Court, Bodinayakanur to the proposed Sub Court, Bodinayakanur.

3. In the meantime, the Hon'ble Minister for Law, while moving the Demand for Grants relating to Administration of Justice (Demand No.3), has made, among others, the following Announcement on the floor of the Assembly on 27.04.2022:-

"Constitution of a Sub Court at Bodinayakanur in Theni District".

4. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras, have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government accord sanction for a sum of Rs.1,95,70,252/- (Rupees one crore ninety five lakh seventy thousand two hundred and fifty two only)[viz. Rs.1,79,27,252/- as recurring expenditure and Rs.16,43,000/- as non recurring expenditure] towards constitution of Sub Court at Bodinayakanur in Theni District by sanctioning 21 new posts and other infrastructure facilities.

6. The incumbents of the posts sanctioned in para 4 above are eligible for pay and other allowances as per orders in force.

7. The Director of Stationery and Printing, Chennai is directed to supply stationery articles, requisite forms and registers to the above said court at free of cost against the specific indent of the Judicial officer concerned.

8. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is requested to send necessary draft notifications to the Government for its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, under the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 [Central Act III of 1873] for the commencement of the above said court and also to send the draft Notification under first proviso to section 13 of the said Act to be published by the High Court, for approval of the Government.

The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course of time by an inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period up to next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to the Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras shall also send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2022-2023 to Finance (BG-II/Home-II) Department at the appropriate time, without fail.
